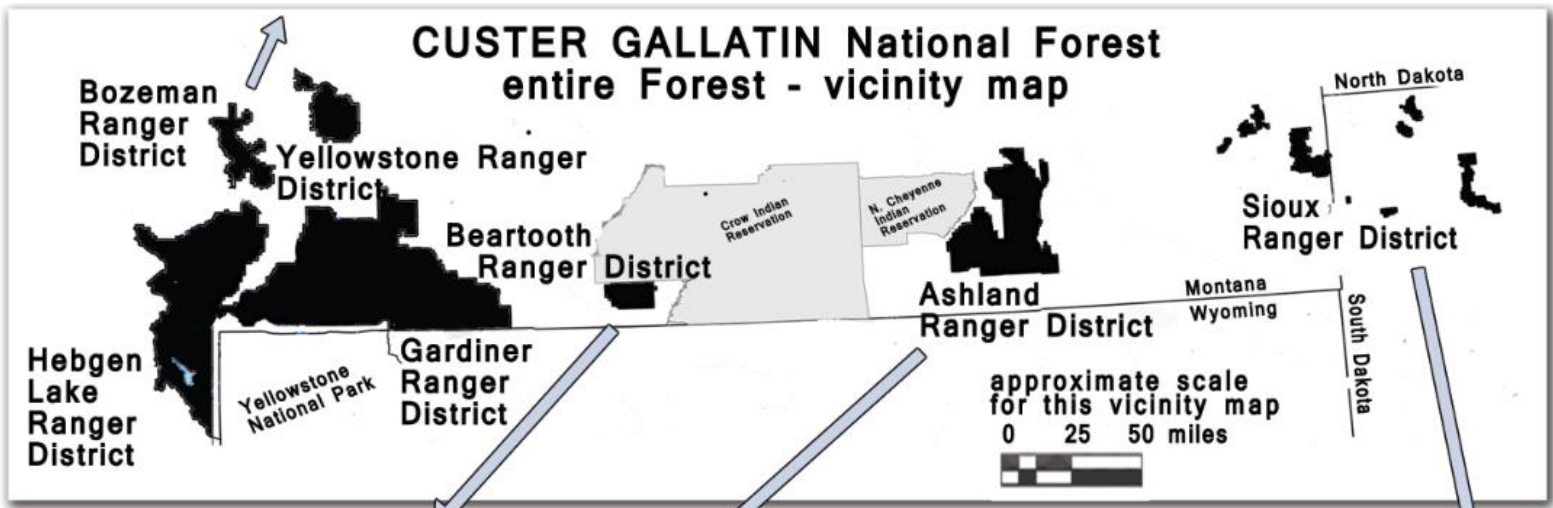
WEST SIDE OF FOREST

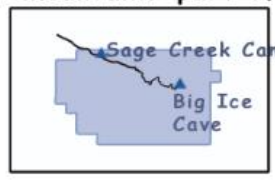

CUSTER GALLATIN National Forest entire Forest - vicinity map



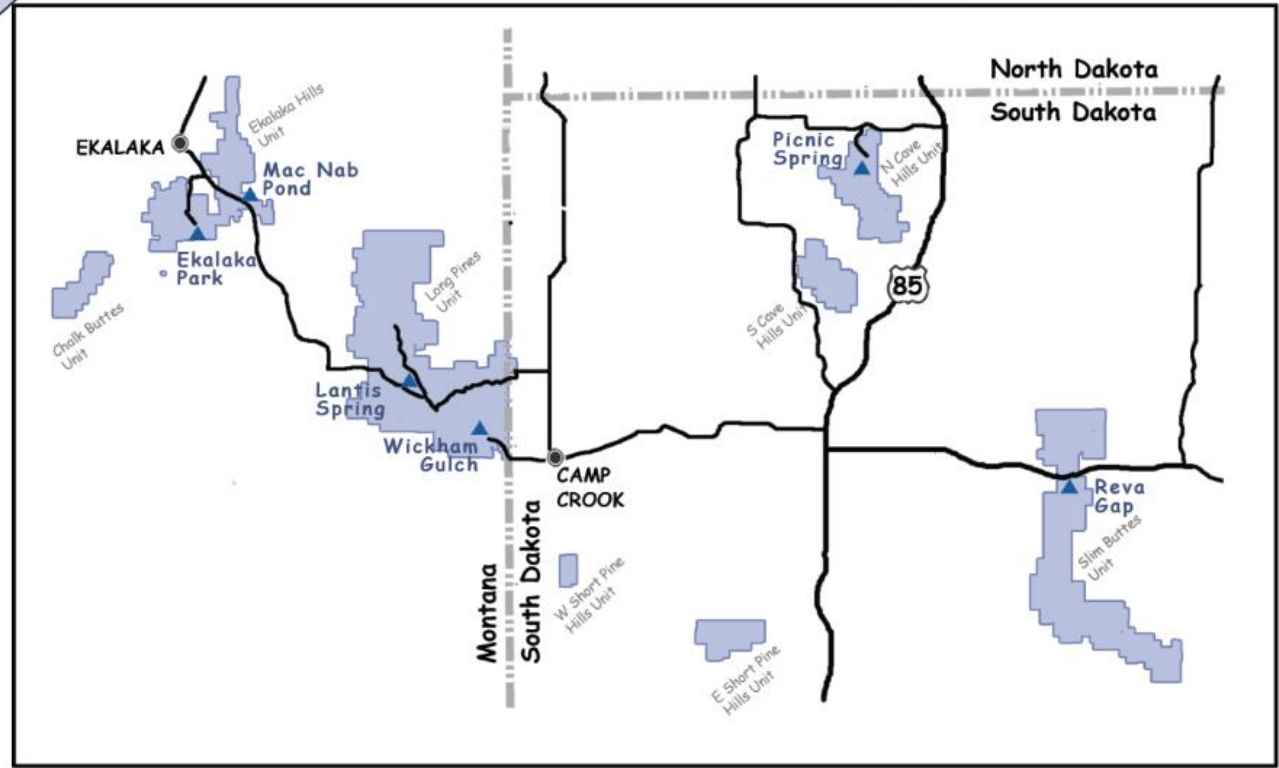

Pryor Mountains-part of Beartooth District

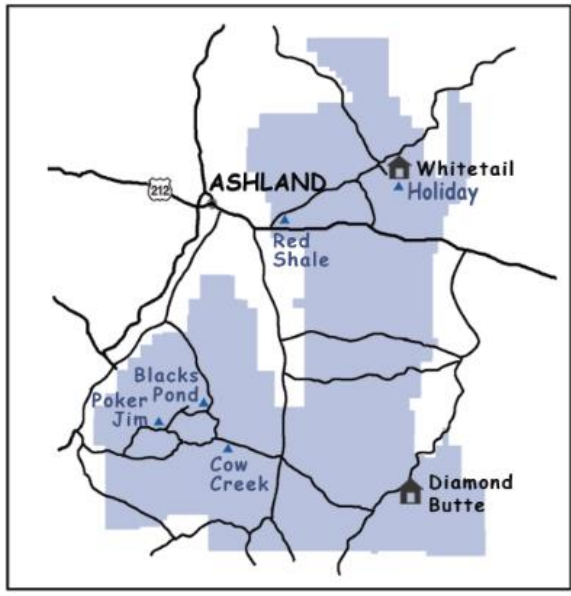

Welcome to the Custer Gallatin National Forest

To ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable visit, please remember:



Camping is limited to 16 days in any one campground or location (14-day limit in the South Dakota units of the Sioux District).



Keep a clean camp. Store all food and wildlife attractants properly. The **Food Storage Order is in effect Forest-wide March 1-Dec 1** (except in the Ashland and Sioux Ranger Districts). Your safety and the safety of others depends upon you.



Camping with stock is not allowed in most developed campgrounds. Call the local ranger districts for more information, or check our website for stock facilities.



Be aware that natural hazards exist, even in developed campgrounds and recreation sites.



Dispose of garbage appropriately. Keep our waters clean by disposing of dishwater far away from any water source. Recycle your recyclables.



CAR CAMPING OUTSIDE OF DEVELOPED CAMPGROUNDS

“Dispersed” car camping in locations with no facilities is allowed ONLY as specified in the **Custer Gallatin National Forest Motor Vehicle Use Maps**. Where car camping is limited to designated campsites only, all legal car campsites are marked.

Fireworks and other explosives are prohibited in the National Forest.


No discharging of firearms in or near a developed recreation site.

Federal Recreation Passes are accepted at all fee campgrounds and apply only to the basic campsite fee.

Along with multi-colored buttes and wildlife galore, Ashland District's topography contrasts from rolling grasslands to steep rock outcroppings. It offers wonderful opportunities for exploration along with a good dose of solitude. Three large non-motorized areas appeal to those looking for rolling Ponderosa pine woodlands and open meadows, studded with interesting cliffs and rocky formations for cross-country hiking, riding, and hunting.

BEARTOOTH RANGER DISTRICT, 6811 US Hwy 212, Red Lodge, MT 59068, (406) 446-2103

Encompassing the Pryor Mountains with its unusual mix of pine forests and limestone canyons and the eastern side of the Beartooth Mountains where the glaciated valleys and granite walls awe visitors, the Beartooth District abounds with recreational opportunities. Camping facilities and picnic areas on the district provide for a pleasant afternoon by a river or a longer stay that allows more in-depth exploration of this spectacular area. Sites listed as year-round may not be accessible outside of the heavy use season due to weather conditions. After the heavy use season, all open sites receive a reduction in services, this may include less frequent restroom cleanings and no garbage services.

From the area around the town of Gardiner to the eastern high country near Cooke City, the Gardiner District landscape ranges from the banks of the Yellowstone River and the rock formations of the Petrified Forest of the east Gallatin Mountains, up to the tundra of the Beartooth Mountains within the Absaroka Beartooth Wilderness. Much of the Gardiner District wraps along the north side of Yellowstone National Park and is adjacent to the North and Northeast Entrances of the Park.

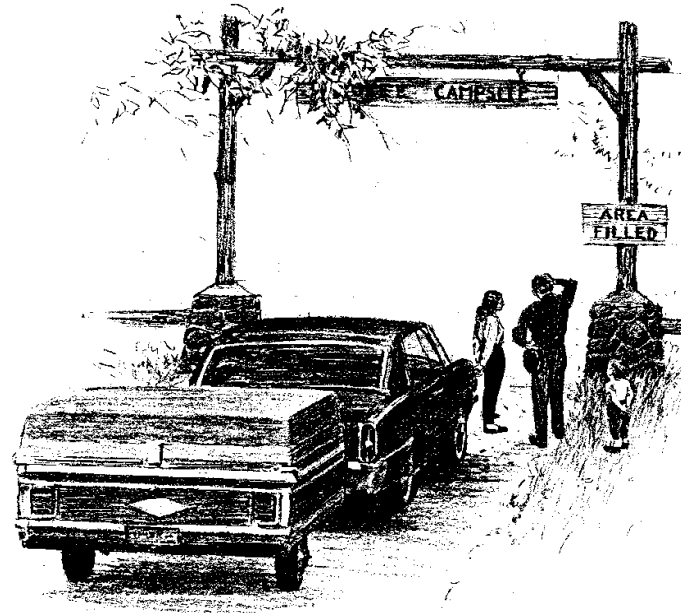
