APPLICATION for Golden Trout Wilderness Overnight Visitor's Permit, Sequoia National Forest, Giant Sequoia National Monument
(this is not a permit)

Wilderness Permits are required for *overnight* stay in the Golden Trout Wilderness

Sequoia National Forest Trailheads Open for 2026 Season:

Blackrock, Clicks Creek, Forks of the Kern, Jerkey, Lewis Camp, Long Canyon (Shake Camp), and Summit Trailheads.

A separate wilderness permit is required for each trip.
How to submit your application for an overnight Golden Trout Wilderness Permit:

A group of less than 15 persons camping and traveling together only needs one permit. Groups larger than 15 cannot be combined.

This permit will be valid for travel into adjacent Forest Service and National Park Service wilderness areas, as specified on your itinerary. Wilderness conditions are primitive.

If starting your trip from a Park Service trailhead, you must obtain a permit from the National Park Service. Trips leaving from Inyo National Forest must be obtained from the Inyo National Forest. Trips leaving from the Sequoia National Forest are obtained from the Sequoia National Forest.

Plan accordingly - Some areas have visitor and trailhead quotas, reservation requirements, and charge a fee for the issuance of visitor passes. Collecting this information about where visitors travel helps track visitor use patterns to protect the wilderness from visitor impacts and overuse.

CAMPFIRES: In areas where campfires are allowed, you will need a valid Campfire Permit which can be obtained for free from: <https://permit.preventwildfiresca.org/>

Campfire and stove use may be restricted. It is your responsibility to check on the current regulations at any Forest Service office or National Park office.
