East Zone Firewood Information September 6, 2026

Industrial Fire Precaution Levels (IFPL):

Unit 1: Barlow & HR Districts (East of US 26 & OR 35) IFPL III "High" Fire Danger

General Shutdown ALL OPERATIONS ARE PROHIBITED.

Unit 4: Hood River Ranger District (West of OR 35) IFPL II "High" Fire Danger

All power equipment must be shut down by 1:00 PM.

Chainsaws equipped with .023" or smaller mesh spark arrestor, carry 8" shovel and 8 oz. or larger pressurized fire extinguisher. Remain on site for one hour fire watch after equipment shutdown to extinguish new starts.

- Mt. Hood National Forest permits the harvest of up to six cords per household each year for personal use.
- Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.6 (F), firewood obtained under this free use authorization may not be sold or exchanged. Please visit our website or call to inquire about the \$10/cord commercial firewood permit.
- Bring your signed permit, load tags, map, and information sheet with you when gathering firewood.
- Firewood Permits are not valid on roads that are shown as closed on the Motor Vehicle Use Map.

In the hatched areas on the map (LSR), you may cut within 100 feet of the road after July 15th.

Roads surrounding The Dalles Watershed (44, 4410, 1700 & 1720) are open to cutting all season within 100 feet of road.

Woodcutting areas in the Barlow and Hood River Ranger Districts are being impacted by the Grasshopper Fire Closure: FOREST ORDER NO. 06-06-01-26-15.

Firewood permits are not exempt from wildfire closures, please plan accordingly.
