West Zone Firewood Information September 6, 2026

Industrial Fire Precaution Level (IFPL)

Unit 2: Clackamas River & Zigzag Ranger Districts IFPL II “High” Fire Danger

All power equipment must be shut down by 1:00 PM.

Chainsaws must be equipped with .023 inch or smaller mesh spark arrestor. Carry an 8-inch-wide shovel and 8-ounce (or larger) pressurized fire extinguisher while woodcutting. Remain on site for one hour fire watch after equipment shutdown to extinguish new starts. IFPL unit map and info available online:

Memaloose Weigh Station Firewood Decks: Hwy 224, MP 33.5 indicated by green woodcutting area signs on the south end near the old scales. Re-supplied as available. Valid Free use firewood permit required. Please respect “no woodcutting” signs posted on habitat wood decks.

Winter storm blowdown including dead and downed wood along forest roads within the general woodcutting area as indicated on the [Westside Firewood Cutting Map](#).

No woodcutting within these active timber sale areas:

Trillium Lake Loop Road 2656: Blowdown from winter storms, cutting permitted within 100 feet of the center of road 2656 and spurs 2656-XXX except for riparian buffers. Anticipate heavy weekend traffic and show permit to proceed through check point at entrance to Trillium Lake.

Road 31/Hwy 26 junction: Look for green “woodcutting area” signs while supply lasts.

Laurel Hill Quarry: CLOSED

No woodcutting due to ongoing work on site; anticipated to re-open in October.
