Clark Fork River Area (north side of the river)



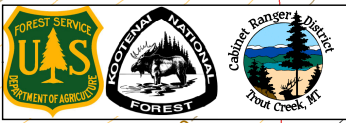
OVERVIEW	Bull River Campground Fishing Access Trail #996 is a short trail that starts at the boat launch area, just off Highway 200 in Bull River Campground. The trail travels through the campground and goes up Bull River a short distance offering fishing access.
LENGTH OF TRAIL	.5 miles one way
ELEVATION	Beginning/Ending: 2188'
DIFFICULTY	Easy
FACILITIES	Ample parking is available for vehicles at the trailhead. There is an outhouse located at the trailhead and additional outhouses throughout Bull River Campground.
DIRECTIONS	Bull River Campground is located at mile marker 10.4 on Montana Highway 200. The trailhead is located in the boat launch parking area adjacent to the outhouse.
TRAIL CONDITIONS	Bull River Campground Fishing Trail Access Trail #996 is a Trail Class 3 trail. The trail tread and corridor will be very well defined and visible. The trail is scheduled to be cleared every year. Please contact Cabinet Ranger Station for current trail conditions.
