

Previous Stakeholder Analysis in Plan Revision

In late 2018, several forums were hosted by the National Forest Foundation and Conservation Connect Program in partnership with the Forest Service for stakeholders of the Lolo and Bitterroot National Forests. The purpose of these forums was to provide opportunities to learn about the values, interests, concerns, and goals of the stakeholders and to build relationships. The context of the forums was to prepare for land management plan revision.

Who attended the forums?

The forums were attended by a wide array of stakeholders. However, as this was not specific to an actual revision effort or a proposed action, it was not a broad outreach for comment.

What was the involvement of Lolo or Bitterroot National Forest staff or leadership in these forums?

The forums did not include direct involvement of staff or leadership and were held prior to receiving a confirmed land management plan revision schedule.

How much engagement with stakeholders has occurred since the 2018 forums?

No additional engagement of these or any other stakeholders on the topic of land management plan revision on the Lolo or Bitterroot National Forests has occurred since these forums were held.
