Saguache Campground Information

- All Campgrounds are **First Come-First Serve**
- Check out: 11am Check in: 2pm
- Generator hours: 6am to 10pm
- Site capacity: 2-3 tents, 2 cars or vehicle + 1 trailer/camper, 8-10 people. Fee charged per day for extra vehicles.
- Dogs must be under control at all times.
- Water and trash service for forest visitors is available at the Saguache Ranger District Office.

To Make a Cabin Reservation

Site reservations may be made up to six months in advance.

Saguache District cabins and campgrounds are generally open from May to November with the exception of the Upper Crossing Guard Station which is open year round.* Check the Rio Grande website or call the Saguache Ranger District Office for up to date information.

** Campgrounds open outside of the summer season will have limited amenities and may be hard to access due to road conditions.*



Leave No Trace

Plan Ahead and Prepare	Know the rules, read the signs
Camp on Durable Surfaces	Only park and camp in allowed areas
Dispose of Waste Properly	Pack out all trash, don't burn it
Leave What You Find	Take pictures so other can enjoy too
Minimize Camp-fire Impacts	Know fire restrictions; use provided fire rings
Respect Wildlife	Don't feed wildlife, properly store all bear attractants
Respect Other Visitors	Minimize noise; be nice, say hi

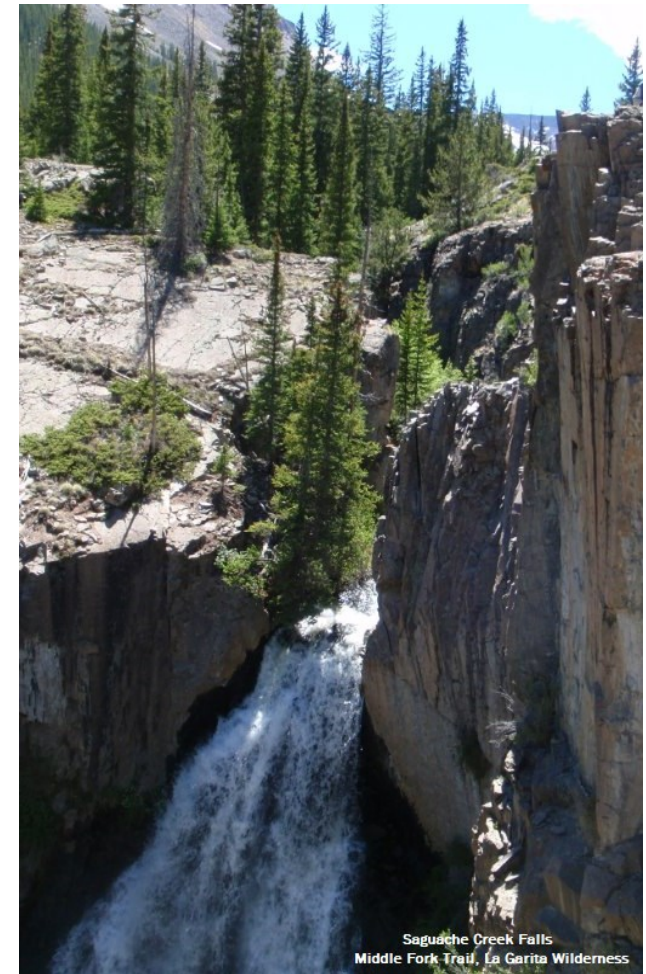

Buffalo Pass

From Saguache, take Hwy 114 west 26.7 miles to campground sign. Turn left at sign onto a single lane dirt road and go 0.6 miles to the campground.



Luders Creek

From Saguache, drive 21 miles west on Hwy 114. Turn left onto County Road NN14 and proceed 8 miles west to the campground. Three stock-friendly Campsites include a corral and adequate parking for trailers.



North Crestone Creek

In Crestone, CO, at the intersection of Galena and Alder Streets, take Alder St. north 1.3 miles to the campground



Poso

From Saguache, CO, take US 285 south 17 miles to the La Garita turnoff and turn right at County Road G. Go 6 miles west to Road 41G. Bear right and proceed 8 miles to FS 675. Turn left and go 1.7 miles to the campground.



Storm King

From Saguache, CO, take US 285 south 17 miles to the La Garita turnoff and turn right at County Road G. Go 6 miles west to Road 41G and proceed an additional 14.5 miles to the campground. Turn right at the sign.



Stone Cellar

From Saguache, CO, take Hwy 114 west 34 miles over North Pass. Turn left on County Road 17GG and proceed 4 miles to the intersection of County Road NN14. Turn left for 1 mile and then turn right on County road 17FF/Forest Road 787. Proceed 13 miles south to the campground.

Brewery Creek Guard Station

From Saguache, CO, go north on US 285 approximately 15 miles to Villa Grove. Turn left on County Road LL56 to Bonanza. Proceed 13 miles west and look for the "Brewery Creek" sign and make a left turn and cross a bridge. Remain on Forest Road 880 for 1.5 miles. Cabin entrance is through a gate on the right hand side.



Carnero Guard Station

From Saguache, CO, go south on US 285 17.5 miles to the La Garita turnoff at County Road G. Turn right and proceed through the town of La Garita to County Road 41G. Bear right and stay on the road for approximately 17 miles. Look for the cabin entrance gate on the right.



Stone Cellar Guard Station

From Saguache, CO, take Hwy 114 west 34 miles over North Pass. Turn left on County Road 17GG and proceed 4 miles to the intersection of County Road NN14. Turn left for 1 mile and then turn right on County road 17FF/Forest Road 787. Proceed 13 miles south and bear right at the campground. Cabin is .5 mile on the left.



Upper Crossing Guard Station

From Saguache, CO, take Hwy 114 approximately 22 miles west. Look for the Upper Crossing sign and turn right. Proceed .03 mile to a T-intersection and turn right for .08 mile. Cabin is on the left.

Dispersed Camping

- Camp at already established dispersed sites.
- Stay 150' from water sources.
- Stay within 300' of the road.
- **Do not leave campfires unattended.**
- 14 day stay limit within 30 days on the RGNF.
- Follow **Leave No Trace Principles**
