



Management Areas

The management direction shown on this map and defined in the Revised Land and Resource Management Plan or FEIS applies to National Forest System Lands only. The direction does not apply to private, state, or other ownerships (shown in white). The legal and administrative boundaries shown on this map are approximate. The location of land ownerships or legal designations are the best available at this time. Accurate landline locations are determined prior to the implementation of projects. Portions of the Rawah and Neota Wilderness Areas that lie within the Routt National Forest boundary will be managed using the same direction as adjacent areas on the Roosevelt National Forest. ARNF and Rocky Mountain National Park share the goal to coordinate management. For display purposes, Forest Service Management Area Prescription numbers that reflect Park Service management have been applied to the existing National Park management strategy, and do not indicate a management decision. Any discrepancies between this map and the map printed with the Forest Plan in 1997 are due to Forest Plan amendments.
