Special Order Closure
San Juan-Rio Grande National Forests

Pursuant to Title 16 USC, Section 551 and Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) & (b). The following is in effect until further notice on the Pagosa Ranger District, San Juan National Forest:

LOWER PIEDRA CAMPGROUND:

It is prohibited to camp in the area adjacent to the Lower Piedra Campground, within 100 yards on both sides of Forest Development Road #621, from the cattleguard to the boundary of the Lower Piedra Campground (T34N, R4W, section 5, NMPM) [261.58(e)]. See Attachment #1, item A.

WILLIAMS CREEK CAMPGROUND:

It is prohibited to camp within 300 yards of the Williams Creek Campground, (T38N, R3W, Section 30 NMPM.) [261.58(e)]. See Attachment #2, item B.

CIMARRONA CAMPGROUND:

It is prohibited to camp within 300 yards of the Cimarrona Campground (T38N, R3W, Section 8 NMPM.) [261.58(e)]. See Attachment #2 item C.

These areas have been identified to lesson user conflict, resource impacts and sanitation concerns in and around the listed campgrounds.

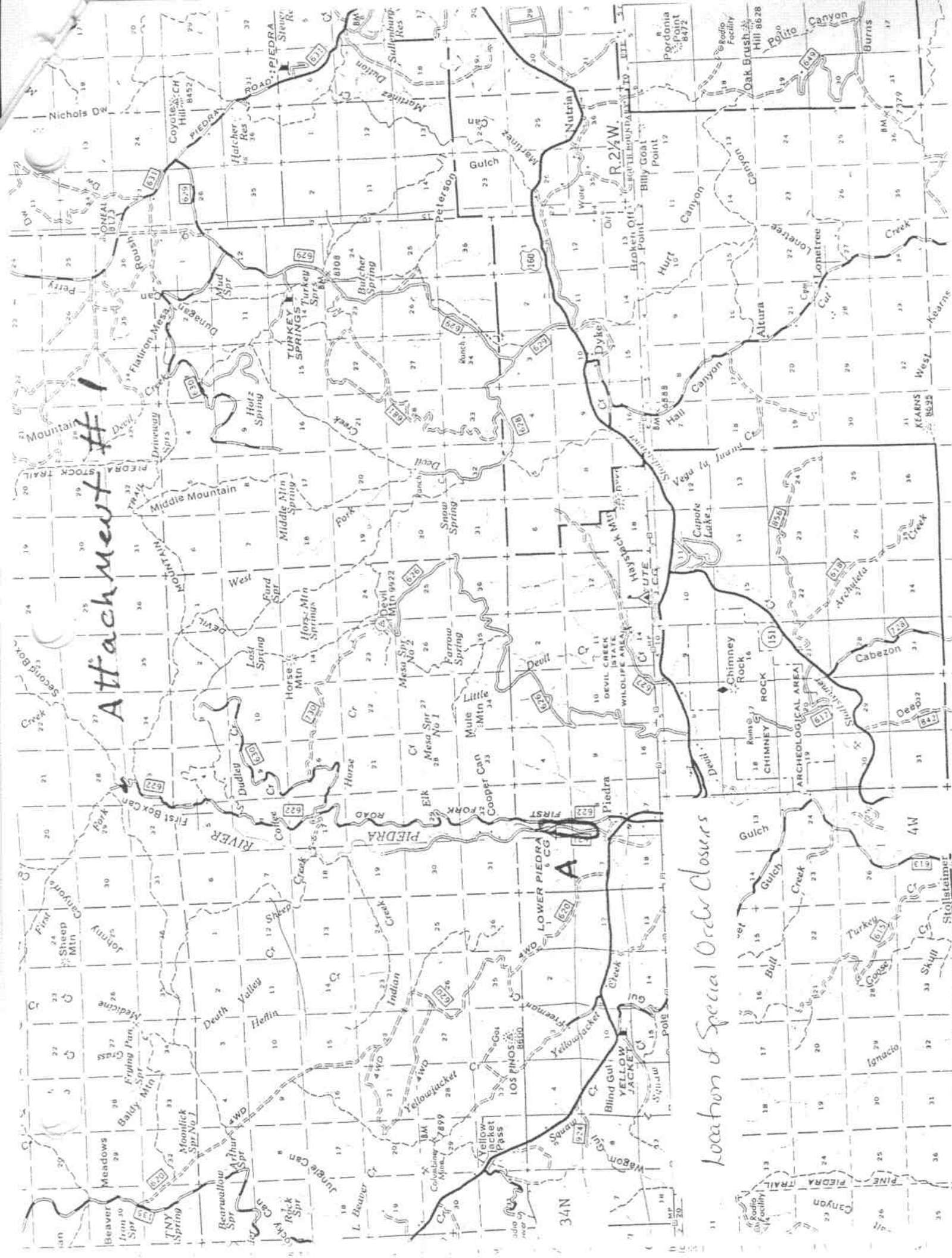
Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons camped in designated sites within the above named campgrounds.
