### **DEFINITIONS:**

**National and Regional Lead Forest Responsibilities** – These forests are responsible for conducting meaningful consultation with Tribal nations for **national and regional** activities that include but are not limited to agency notifications, initiatives, policies, regulations and guidance.

**Regional Lead Forest Responsibilities** - These forests are responsible for conducting meaningful consultation with Tribal nations on **regional** activities that include but are not limited to notifications, initiatives, policies, regulations and guidance.

**Secondary Forest Responsibilities** – These forests provide back-up and assistance on consultative matters as identified by the lead forest. The terms and understanding of "back-up" and "assistance" will be negotiated between the lead and secondary forests.

**Tribal Nations** – Tribal nations that own land within the Rocky Mountain regional boundaries.

**Affiliated Tribal Nations** – Tribal nations that recognize landscapes, trails, sacred sites, historically and culturally significant locations within the Rocky Mountain regional boundaries.

Meaningful Consultation – see Forest Service Manual 1560, FSH 1563.18

The lead forest approach is intended to improve the quality of Forest Service consultation by eliminating redundancy; promoting agency consistency in messaging, meaning, and contact; being sensitive to the consultative constraints and interest levels of tribal governments; and strengthening our relationships in order to fulfill our legal mandate to consult with Tribal nations, traditional practitioners, culturally affiliated and affected tribal nations.
