

Yavapai Resource Advisory Committee

Member Selection

RAC member appointment requirements:

- 15 members on the committee
- Three categories specified in the Act (A, B, C)
- At least three and no more than five members must be drawn from each category, or the committee does not have a quorum
- Each category includes subcategories representing related yet distinct interest groups
- No legal requirement to have all subcategories represented
- Selection of more than one candidate from the same subcategory is permitted as long as the above rules are met
- ‘Interest not represented’ means no incumbent committee member represents the subcategory and no nomination is offered at this time
