- Keep “Enter as a Guest” selected
- Type your name and state/org abbreviation into the “name” box
- Click “Enter Room”

➤ **For Audio**

- Dial in by phone: 888-844-9904; access code 309 7641# **OR**
- Listen to the audio through the computer

NOTE: If you have a high-speed Internet connection, audio through the computer should work fine (listen through computer speakers or headphones); however, you will need to submit all questions via the Web chat pod (you will not be able to speak up with questions).

To access Adobe Connect, ensure you have a good Internet connection and Adobe Flash Player 11.2 or higher. You can TEST your connection PRIOR to the webinar by clicking the link above or running the [Adobe Connect Test](#). NOTE: you do not need the Adobe Connect add-in.

Although it would be best to connect from a computer with a hard-wired connection (not wireless), you can join from certain mobile devices with the free Adobe Connect Mobile app (iPad or iPhone—download the [iTunes App](#) from the iTunes store; Android devices—download the [Android App](#) from Google Play).

➤ [Keyboard Commands](#) provide accessibility to Adobe Connect. Some important commands include these:

- Ctrl + F6: Move focus from pod to pod in the meeting room (if connecting from a Mac, use the “Command” key instead of “Ctrl”).
- Tab: Access different options within a specific pod.
- Use your screen reader “read all” command (Insert + down arrow in JAWS) to read PowerPoint files shared in the meeting room.
