Dear Interested Party,

You are receiving this notice because you submitted comments during the scoping and/or comment period on a proposal submitted to the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest by Alta Ski Lifts addressing multiple improvement projects at Alta Ski Area. A legal notice initiating the 45-day objection period was published in the Salt Lake Tribune on April 11, 2018 and is posted to the project website.

The environmental assessment and draft decision notice/finding of no significant impact have been completed for the proposal and are available under the "Decision" tab at: <https://www.fs.usda.gov/project/?project=48903>

This project is subject to objection pursuant to 36 CFR 218, Subparts A and B. Only those individuals or organizations who submitted timely specific written comments during a public comment period are eligible to file an objection. Incorporation of documents by reference in the objection is permitted only as provided for at 36 CFR 218.8(b). Minimum content requirements of an objection (36 CFR 218.8) include (1) Objector's name and address with a telephone number if available, with signature or other verification of authorship supplied upon request; (2) Identification of the lead objector when multiple names are listed, along with verification upon request; (3) name of project, responsible official, national forest/ranger district of project, and (4) sufficient narrative description of those aspects of the proposed project objected to, specific issues related to the project, and suggested remedies which would resolve the objection.

Written objections, including any attachments, must be sent via regular mail, fax, email, hand-delivered, or express delivered to Objection Reviewing Officer, USDA-Forest Service Intermountain Region, 324 25th Street, Ogden, UT 84401 within 45 days following the publication date of the legal notice. Hours for submitting hand-delivered objections are: 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. Electronic objections must be submitted in a format such as an email message, .pdf, .txt, .rtf, .doc, or .docx to [objections-intermtn-regional-office@fs.fed.us](mailto:objections-intermtn-regional-office@fs.fed.us). Faxed objections should be sent to (801) 625-5277. Objectors are responsible for ensuring that their objection is received in a timely manner (36 CFR 218.10).
