Dear Interested Party:

Because you have participated in the public involvement process by submitting comments or requested to be notified of availability of the Canyons Healthy Forests Restoration Act (HFRA) Project documents on the Manti-La Sal National Forest, I wanted to inform you that the 30-day pre-decisional objection period for this project started with publication of a legal notice in *The Salt Lake Tribune* on May 28, 2019.

The Environmental Assessment (EA), draft Decision Notice (DN), and copy of the Legal Notice of Opportunity to Object can be found on the project webpage at: <https://www.fs.usda.gov/project/?project=52899>. Information about the pre-decisional objection process can be found in the Pre-decisional Administrative Review section of the draft DN.

I also wanted to clarify that the pre-decisional objection process allows for any objectors or the objection reviewing officer to request a meeting to discuss issues raised in objections and any potential resolutions to those issues. The objection reviewing officer can determine who, other than the objectors, may participate in the resolution meeting.

If you are supportive of the project and do not object to it, but are interested in participating in resolution meetings should objections be received, you are encouraged to communicate your interest to the objection reviewing officer through a letter rather than filing an objection. There is no need to object to the project just to ensure continued engagement in the resolution process. If you would like to send a letter indicating your support and interest, please submit your letters via the same process described in the draft DN for filing objections.

I would like to thank you for your continued interest in this project. The Forest is pleased to have reached this milestone in the project development process.
