Bridger-Teton National Forest (NF) sought scoping comments on Aug. 3, 2018 regarding Snow King's **Proposed Action** for on-mountain improvements. The Town of Jackson stakeholder process informed this proposal.

Add **design criteria** to address issues & compliance with Forest Plan, laws, executive orders, and policy.
