Context:

Southeast Alaska Conservation Council (SEACC) attended several of the USFS Notice of Intent scoping public meetings and State of Alaska Citizen Advisory Committee public meetings. At the meetings, I generally distributed extra maps, recycled maps, or other posters that were taped to walls to members of interested public. At one of the meetings, SEACC requested copies of the original zone maps used at USFS Notice of Intent scoping public meetings. After all the meetings closed out, I rounded up all the extra maps used in meetings and stored them in my office. I have since gone through the pile and shared with additional folks, including SEACC.

Discussion:

I delivered the five Tongass National Forest zone maps, Section 4407 Easement Map, 2016 TLMP Land Use Designation Map, and Outfitter/Guide Use Map. I also followed up with Outfitter/Guide Use Map corresponding Excel worksheet via email. All discussion focused on the maps, keys, and how the presentation of maps changed over time due to confusion regarding the key. SEACC has hired a new Tongass Forest Program Manager, Dan Cannon, and it was his first look and orientation to Tongass National Forest maps. Discussion was preliminary and for orientation purposes only.

SEACC also indicated their dissatisfaction with both Prince of Wales Landscape Level Analysis (POWLLA) and Alaska Roadless Rulemaking (AKRR) continuing during furlough. I indicated the Regional Office would be providing a statement on continuing work shortly.
