This call was scheduled to discuss requested changes to Alternatives 3 and 4. The scope of the changes was provided to Tetra Tech the prior evening.

GIS data. Tetra Tech needs the updated alternatives spatial data for the bulk of the work. Forest Service expects to provide the GIS data today or no later than Friday (4/19). The group agreed that midnight Alaska time constitutes close of business and that “day 1” of Tetra Tech’s response time will begin the following day from receipt of the data.

Community Use priority AKRAs (Alt 3 only). Underlying LUD management requirements still apply; Tetra Tech will provide suggested language to clarify this intent in the DEIS. Where Community Use priority AKRAs would overlap conservation areas, the direction to designate watershed priority AKRAs prevails.

Additional changes to the narrative part for Alternative 3 will be provided by the Forest Service, including recreation roads and direction for conservation areas.

Tetra Tech will submit their request/justification for definitized work under the labor hour contract Friday.
