The group discussed the revised DEIS delivered on May 3rd, incorporating changes to the alternatives. Ken and Jacque noted an unexpected change in acres removed and added under Alternative 3. Jacque explained that it is likely due to the new watershed conservation areas outside of roadless. Tetra Tech to review and discuss with Jacque as needed.

Ken requested that conservation areas outside of roadless acres be added to the comparison of alternatives table.

Ken provided a summary of the USFS schedule.

Our next call will be Tuesday, May 14th at 11:00 a.m. Alaska.

A follow-up call occurred at 3:30 Alaska with Ken, Jacque, Robert, Dave and Randy.

Tetra Tech compared the current alternatives file with the previous version and found that about 50,000 acres previously recorded as *drops* in the alternatives data was changed to *watershed conservation areas* in the new alternatives file, which was consistent with Jacque's assumption explained on the earlier call. Tetra Tech will adjust the Alternative 3 added and removed acres accordingly.
