ALTERNATIVE 6 Full Exemption

Provides maximum additional timber harvest opportunity by exempting the Tongass National Forest from the 2001 Roadless Rule, as requested by the State of Alaska's petition.

2001 Roadless Rule no longer applies.

110 inventoried roadless areas, totaling 9.2 million acres, removed from roadless area protection.

Land management activities guided primarily by forest plan.
