Notice of Opportunity to Comment on the Wild and Scenic River Comprehensive River Management Plan for Nine Wild and Scenic Rivers, Mt. Hood National Forest: Public comment is invited on the Wild and Scenic River project's draft comprehensive river management plan and environmental assessment. The project is in Clackamas, Hood River, Multnomah, and Wasco Counties of Oregon. The Collawash River, Eagle Creek, East Fork Hood River, Fish Creek, Middle Fork Hood River, South Fork Roaring River, and Zigzag River are located solely on lands managed by the Mt. Hood National Forest. South Fork Clackamas River includes National Forest System lands and Bureau of Land Management (BLM) administered lands. The draft comprehensive river management plan contains the river boundaries; river values; management direction, including desired conditions, standards, and guidelines; and monitoring plan. The draft environmental assessment contains the purpose and need for the plan, proposed action, and environmental analysis. Pursuant to 36 CFR 218.25, comments on this proposed project will be accepted for 30 days beginning on the first day after the date of this publication notice. The Forest Service Responsible Official is Richard Periman, Forest Supervisor, Mt. Hood National Forest. To support COVID-19 public health and safety measures, Mt. E-mails submitted to email addresses other than the one listed above, or in formats other than those listed, or containing viruses, will be rejected. This project is subject to predecisional administrative review pursuant to 36 CFR 218. Only individuals or entities (as defined by 36 CFR 218.2) who submit timely and specific written comments (as defined by 36 CFR 218.2) about this proposed project or activity during this or another public comment period established by the Responsible Official will be eligible to file an objection. Comments must be signed or in the case of electronic or telephone submissions, commenters must verify their identity upon request to be eligible to object. Individuals and entities who have submitted specific written comments at this stage will be eligible to object.
