How to Comment and Timeframe

This proposal is subject to the pre-decisional administrative review process, also known as the objection process (36 CFR 218). Specific written comments (36 CFR 218.2) on the proposed activity will be accepted for 30 calendar days following publication of this legal notice in the *Hoosier Times* (Bloomington *Herald-Times* and Bedford *Times-Mail*). The publication date in the newspaper of record is the exclusive means for calculating the comment period. The regulations prohibit extending the length of the comment period.

Office hours for those who wish to hand deliver their comments, are 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday – Friday (except Federal holidays).

It is the responsibility of persons providing comments to submit them by the close of the comment period. Only those individuals or entities who submit timely and specific written comments during a public comment period are eligible to file an objection (36 CFR 218.5). For objection eligibility, each individual or representative from each entity submitting timely and specific written comments must either sign the comment or verify identity upon request. Individuals and organizations wishing to be eligible to object must meet the information requirements in CFR 36 218.25(a)(3). Names and contact information submitted with comments will become part of the public record and will be available for public inspection.
