

Dear Interested Party:

Many government agencies, to include the Forest Service, are transitioning to primarily electronic communications. The Boise NF has been using GovDelivery to facilitate electronic communications. Instructions on how to subscribe are provided below.

How to subscribe in GovDelivery for email notifications about Boise NF projects:

1. Go to <http://www.fs.usda.gov/projects/boise/landmanagement/projects>.
2. At the top of the page you will see *Subscribe to Email Updates*. Enter your email address and click *Submit*.
3. You will be asked to confirm your email address and given the option to password protect your subscription. Check the *data privacy consent box* if you agree with the data privacy policy and click *Submit*.
4. You have now subscribed to receive the Boise NF's Schedule of Proposed Actions (SOPA), which is updated quarterly and shows the status of current projects.

To subscribe to information about Lost Horse or other specific projects or types of projects, update your subscriber preferences by continuing with the below steps.

5. You will see a link to *Subscriber Preferences* on the screen. Click on the link and then click *Add Subscriptions*.
6. Scroll down to *Boise National Forest* and you will see Boise National Forest SOPA already selected. You can uncheck this if you do not want to receive the SOPA. Check the boxes for any other projects you want to receive information for. You can expand the *Projects by Management Unit* and *Projects by Purpose* fields to select projects by Ranger District (or the entire Boise NF) or by activity type (e.g. Fuels Management, Minerals & Geology, Recreation etc.). You will also see current projects categorized under the applicable management unit or activity type.
7. After completing your selections, hit *Submit*. You will now receive any electronic communications applicable to your selections.
