On September 24, 2010 Deputy Forest Supervisor Cheryl Probert decided to allow a competitive sale of approximately 5.75 acres of National Forest System land not less than the market value. The property will be conveyed under authority of the Forest Service Facilities Realignment & Enhancement Act (FSFREA, P.L. 109-54). As part of the sale, an easement will be granted by the purchaser providing public access and limited trailhead parking on the existing road that lies along the eastern border of the parcel.

Appeals must be postmarked or received by the Appeal Deciding Officer within 45 days of the publication of this notice in the Salt Lake Tribune. This date is the exclusive means for calculating the time to file an appeal. Timeframe information from other sources should not be relied on. Incorporation of documents by reference is not allowed.
