Dear Davis:

We have received the appeal you filed regarding the decision by Uinta-Wasatch-Cache District Ranger Catherine Kahlow approving the Mount Olympus Administrative Land Sale. This property is located along the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest boundary and within a residential area known as Olympus Cove.

Regretfully, I must dismiss your appeal as you did not provide comments during the comment period. To be eligible to appeal, individuals or organizations must submit comments during the 30-day comment period (36 CFR 215.13). The following notice was provided in the competitive sale scoping notice, of which you received a copy:

“Anyone providing comments or otherwise expressing interest in the proposed action by the close of the comment period specified in 36 CFR 215.6 will be eligible to appeal the decision pursuant to 36 CFR part 215 regulations. It is important for readers to note that only those commenting during the notice and comment period being offered at this time will be eligible to appeal. Comments received during the first scoping period will not create eligibility to appeal.”

A similar notice requiring comment during the comment period was provided in the legal notice for public comment, which was published in the newspaper.
