Dear Interested Party,

On July 9, 2014 I signed a decision implementing the Proposed Action for the Island Park OHV trails. This decision can be implemented immediately.

This project will designate approximately 42 miles of motorized trail; decommission approximately 15 miles of National Forest System Roads; obliterate approximately 73 miles of user-created routes that are not part of the Forest Transportation System. Several site specific Forest Plan amendments are incorporated into this decision. Cross country OHV travel will not occur on approximately 43,600 acres where it has previously occurred and 400 acres on the west end of Island Park reservoir will be open to cross country OHV travel; motorized road and trail densities will increase in four management prescription areas in Island Park. The details of the project can be found in the Decision Notice, FONSI and Environmental Assessment.
