



HELP FROM THE SBA

SMALL BUSINESS OWNERS, if you have financial losses due to the recent Montana forest fires that began July 23, you may qualify for help from the SBA.

- **WHO QUALIFIES?** -- Small businesses having difficulty meeting operating expenses, payroll, accounts payable and notes payable as a result of the fires.
- **WHAT QUALIFIES?** -- Loss of working capital (business interruption) caused by the forest fires.
- **WHAT ARE THE TERMS?** -- Up to \$1.5 million at 2.953% for up to 30-years.
