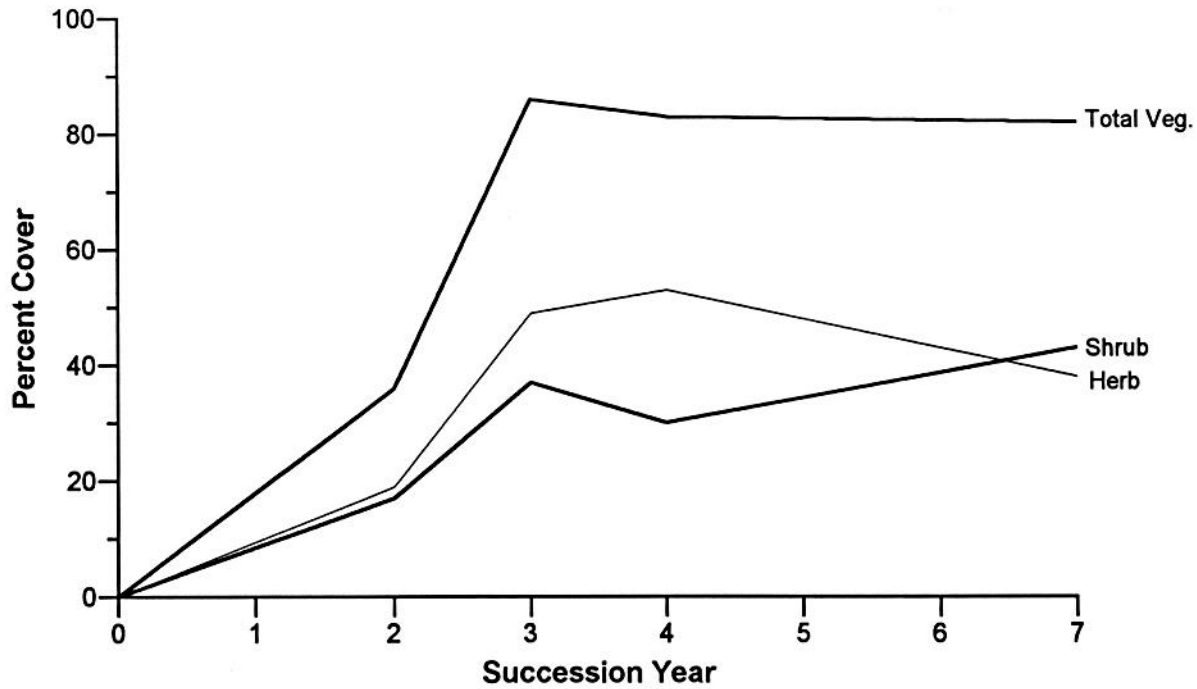


Figure 10-1—Life form cover development, MC-16.

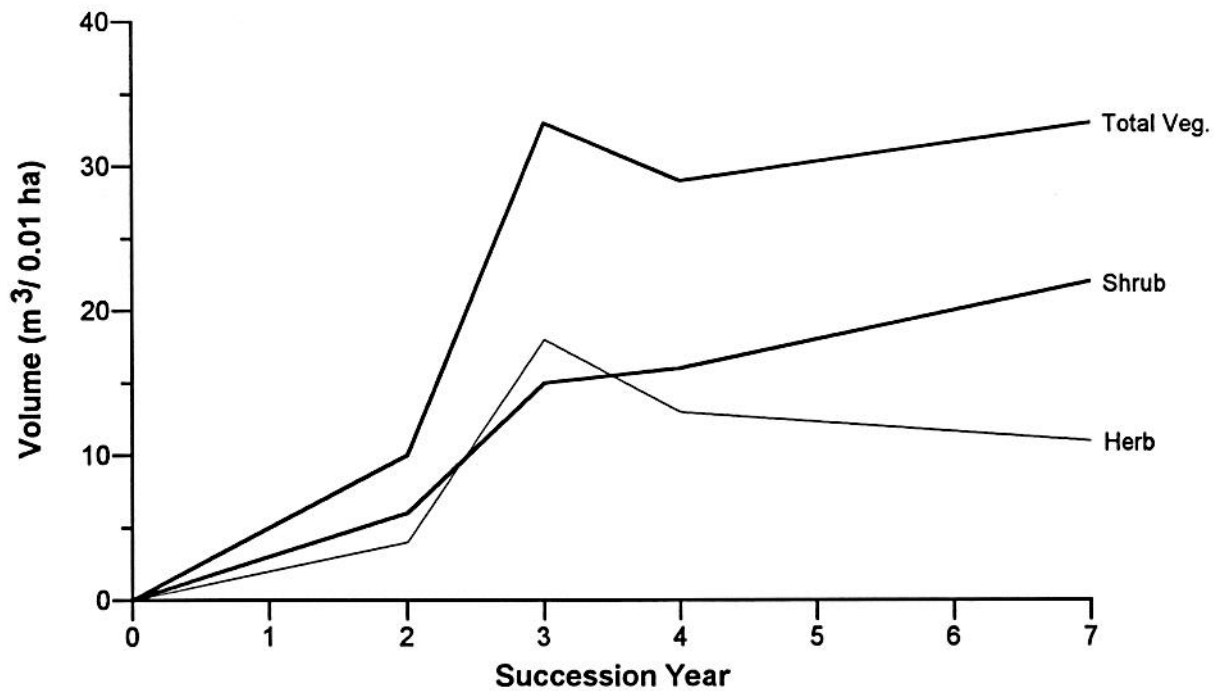


Figure 10-2—Life form volume development, MC-16.

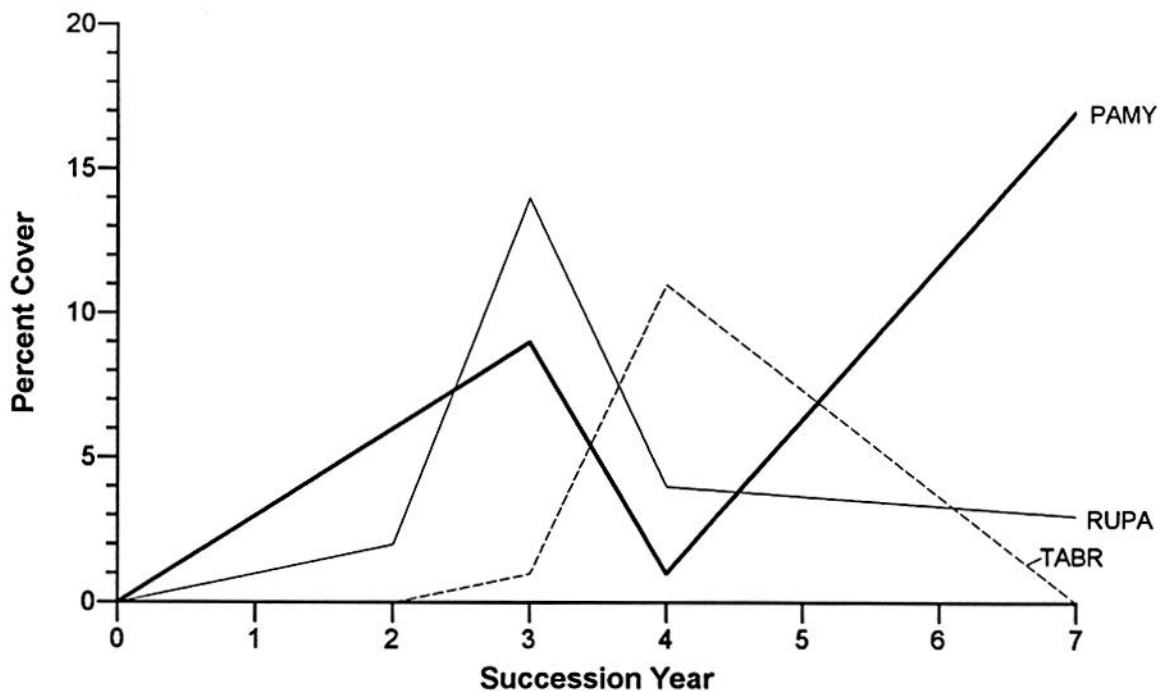


Figure 10-3—Tree and shrub cover development, MC-16.

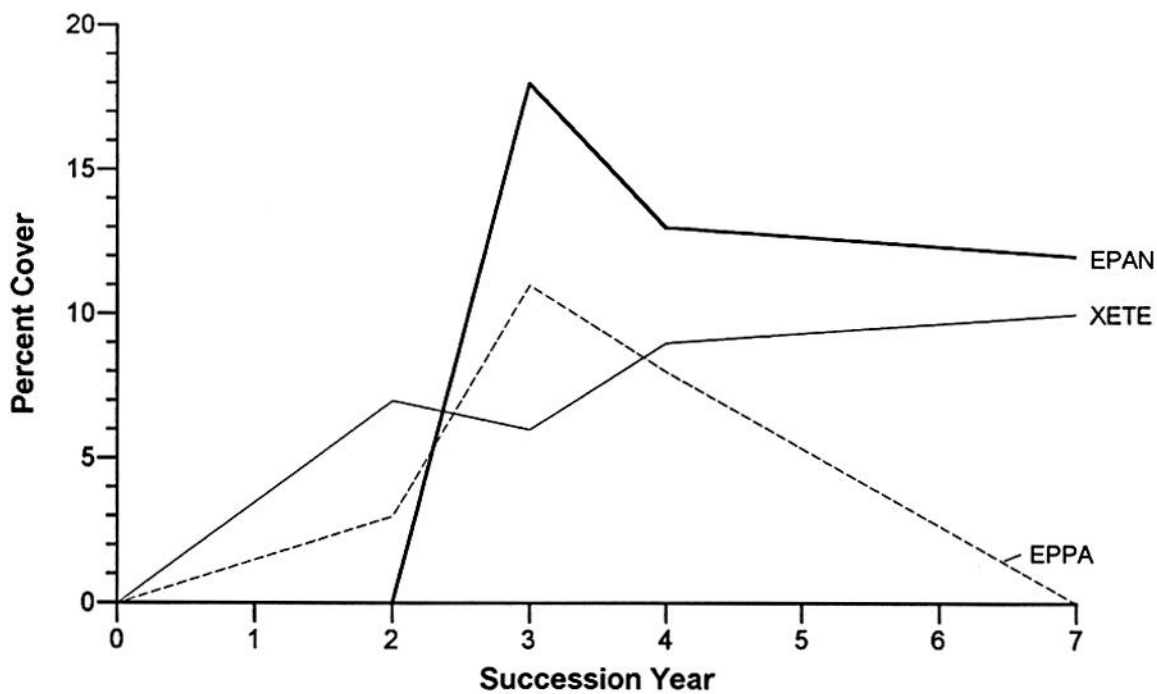


Figure 10-4—Herb cover development, MC-16.

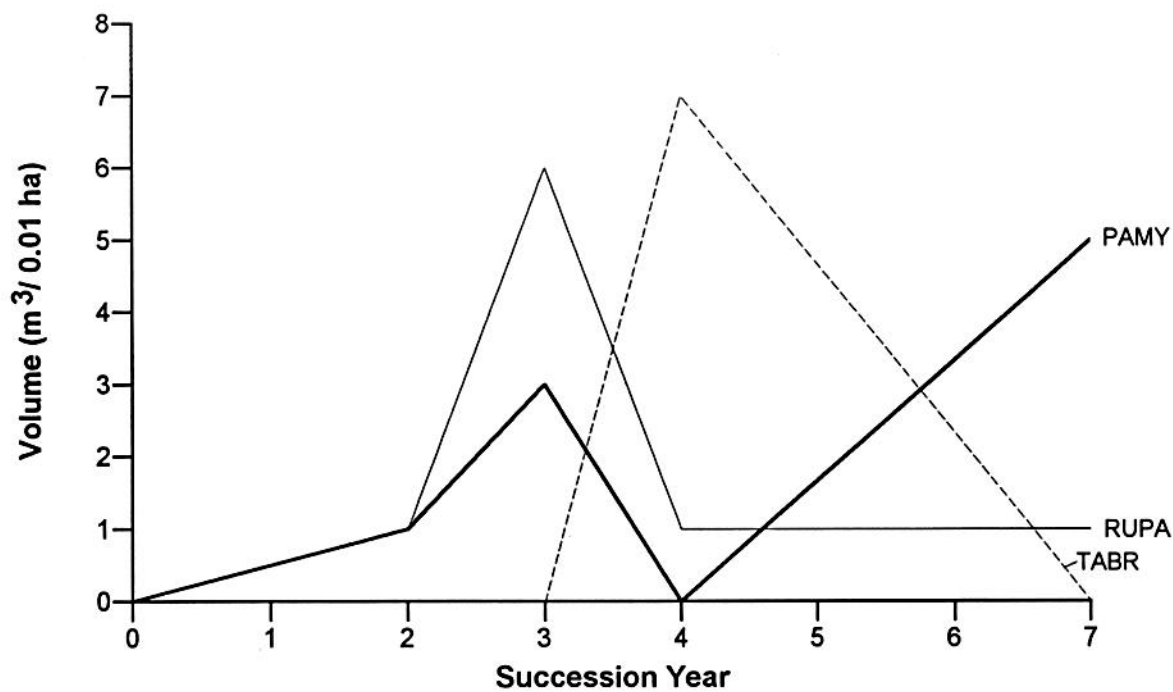


Figure 10-5—Tree and shrub volume development, MC-16.

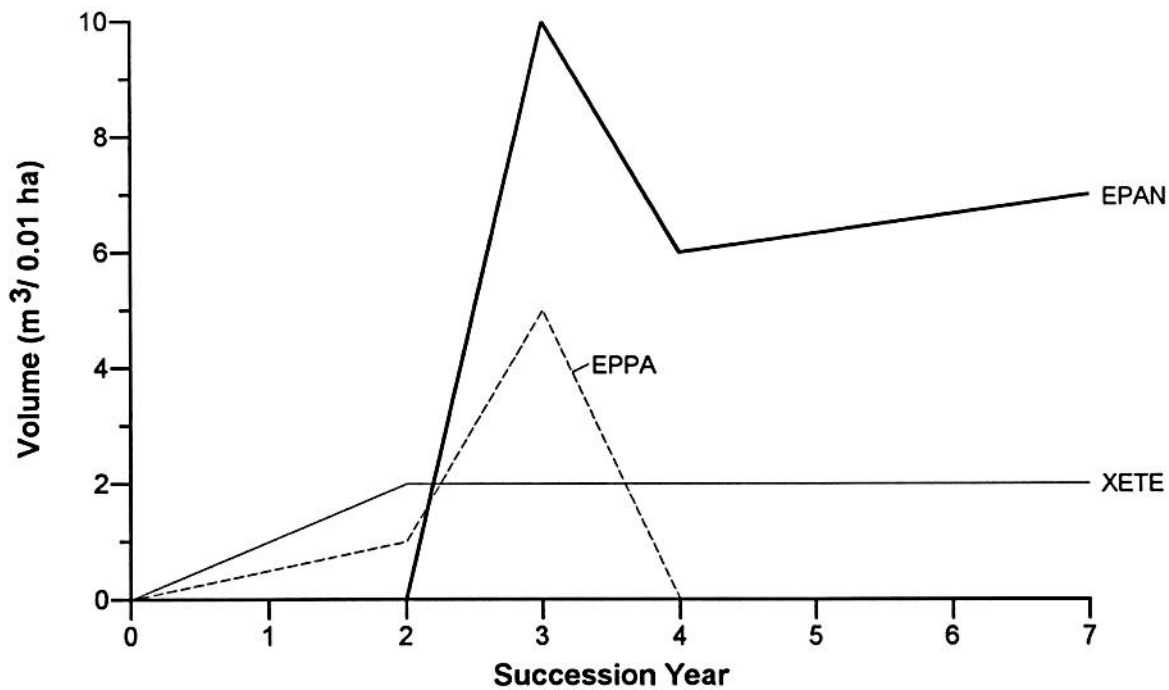


Figure 10-6—Herb volume development, MC-16.
