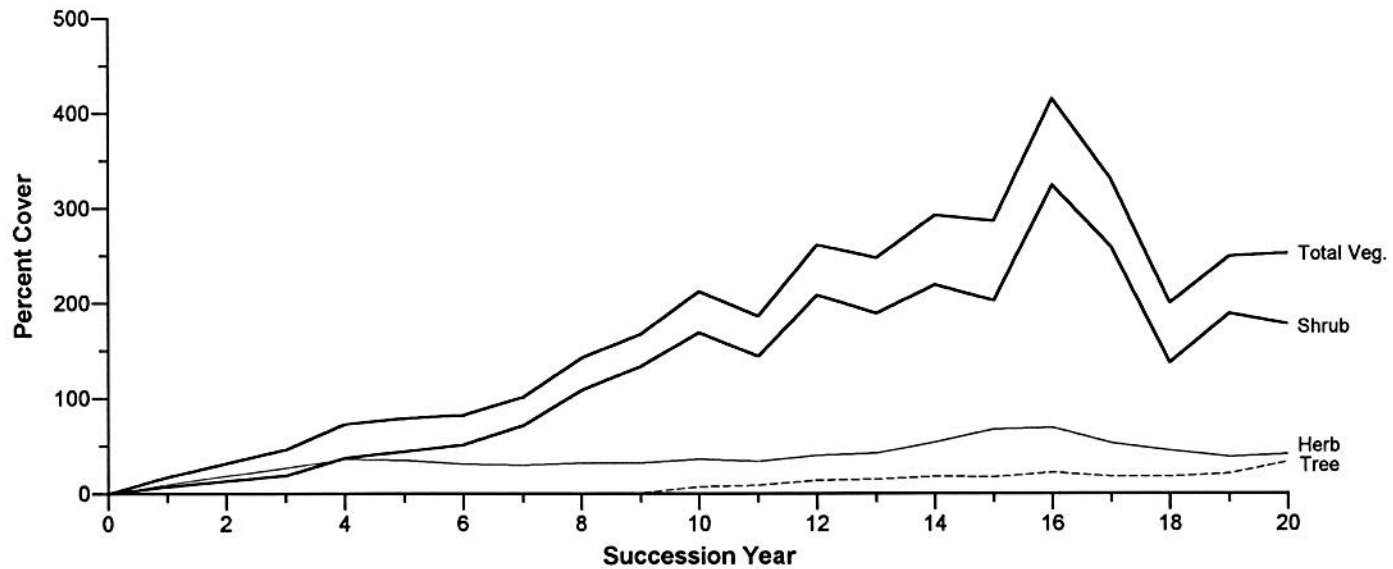


Figure 27-1—Life form cover development, NR-29.

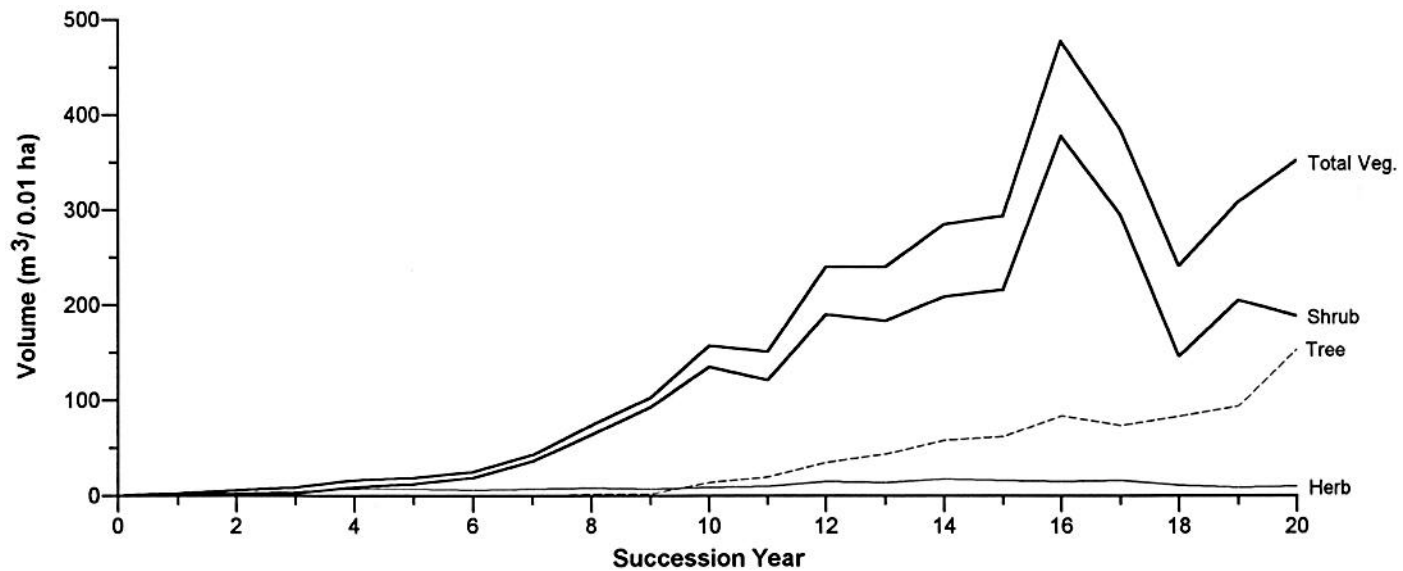


Figure 27-2—Life form volume development, NR-29.

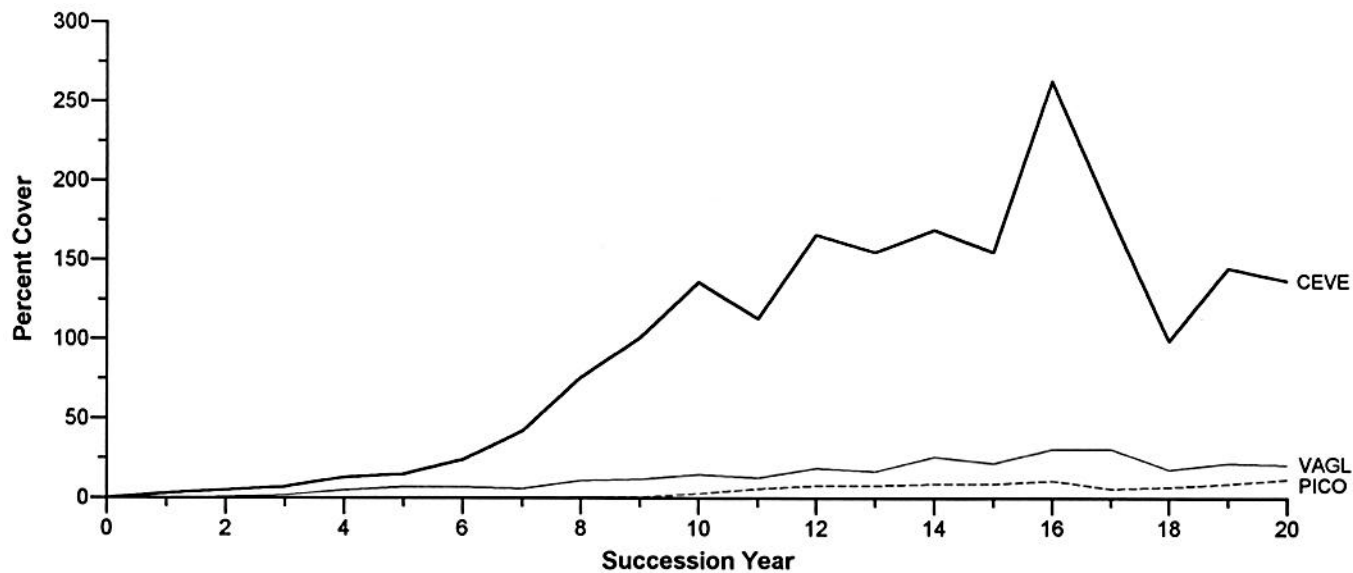


Figure 27-3—Tree and shrub cover development, NR-29.

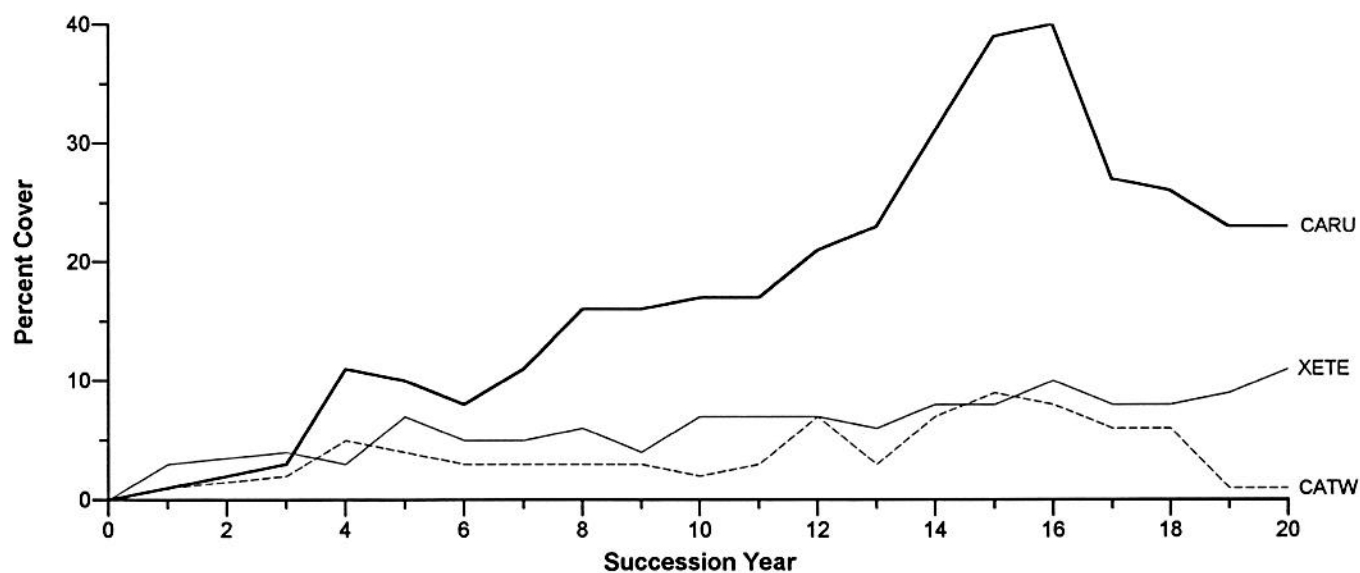


Figure 27-4—Herb cover development, NR-29.

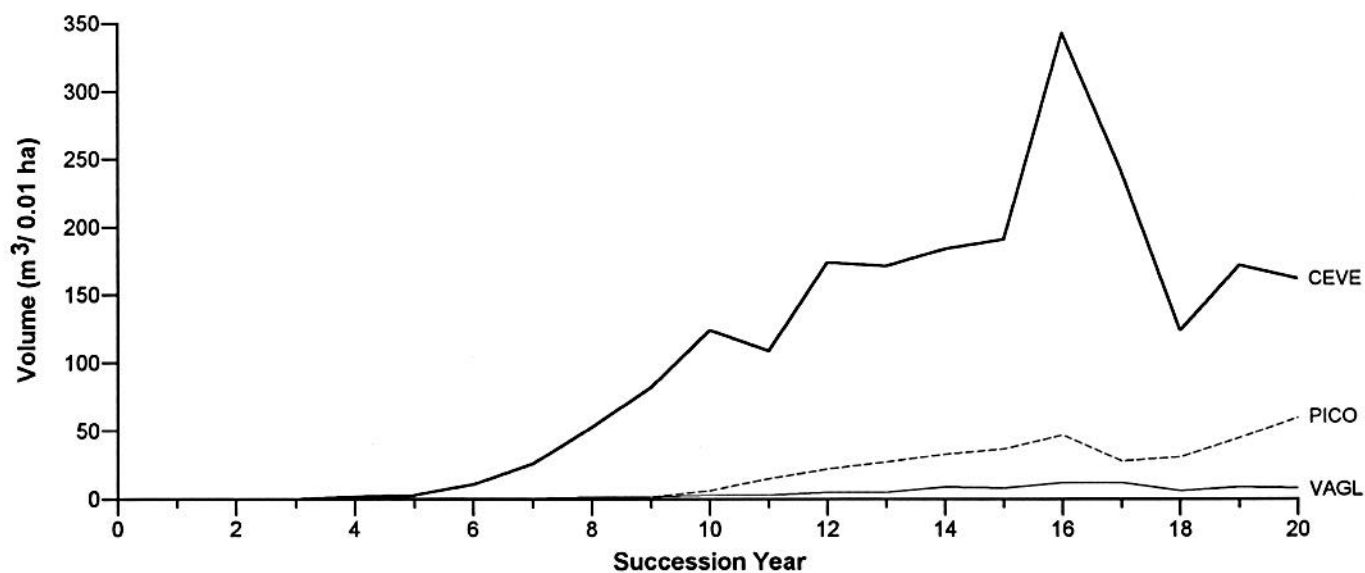


Figure 27-5—Tree and shrub volume development, NR-29.

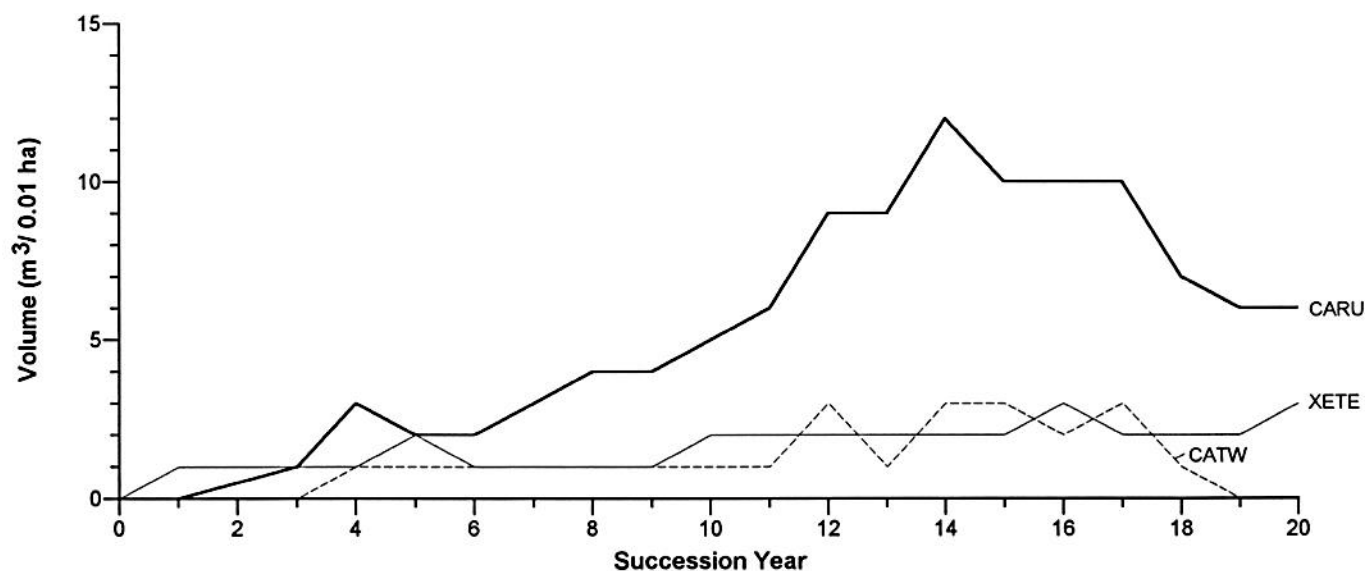


Figure 27-6—Herb volume development, NR-29.
