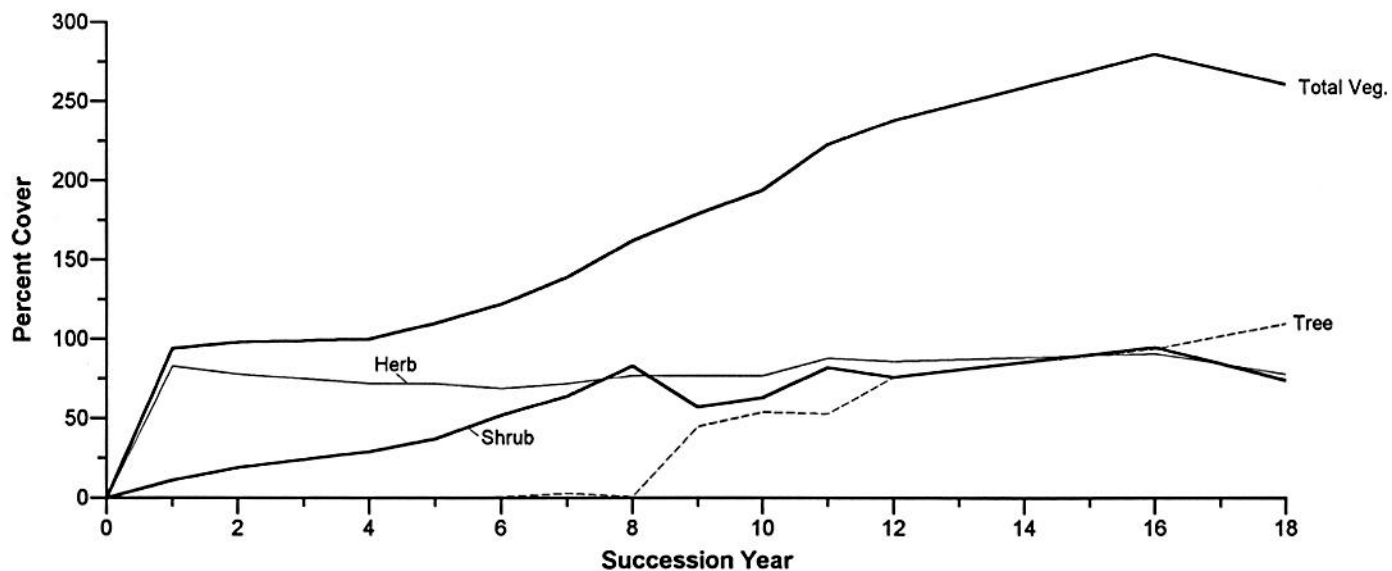


Figure 29-1—Life form cover development, SD-02.

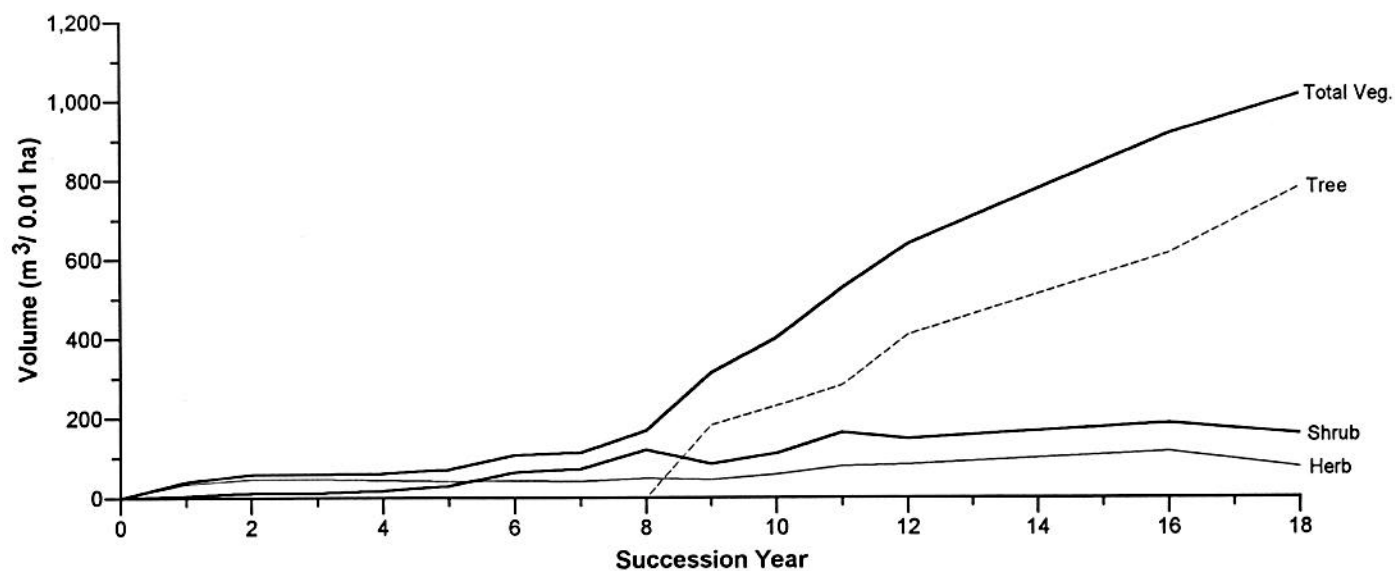


Figure 29-2—Life form volume development, SD-02.

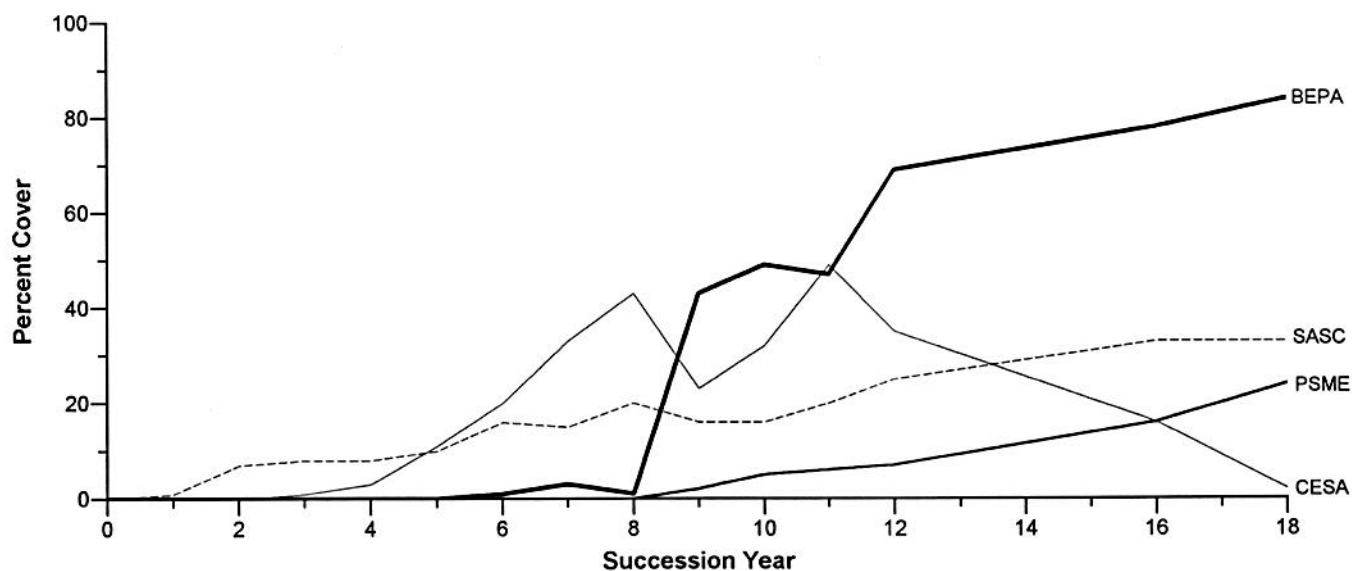


Figure 29-3—Tree and shrub cover development, SD-02.

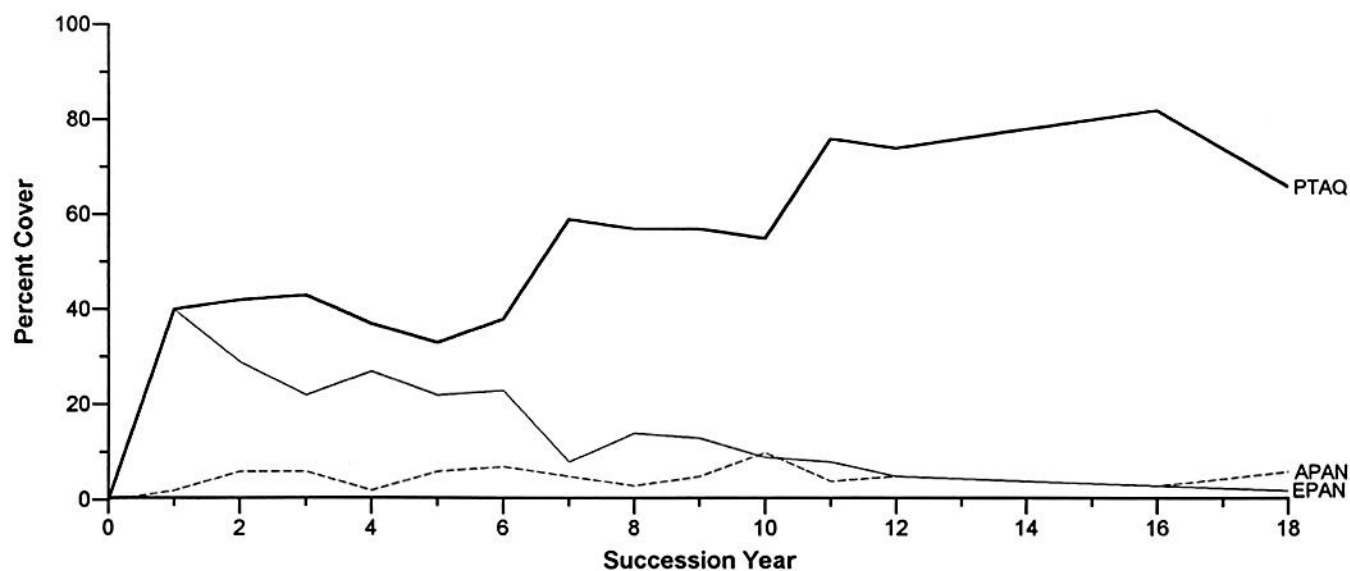


Figure 29-4—Herb cover development, SD-02.

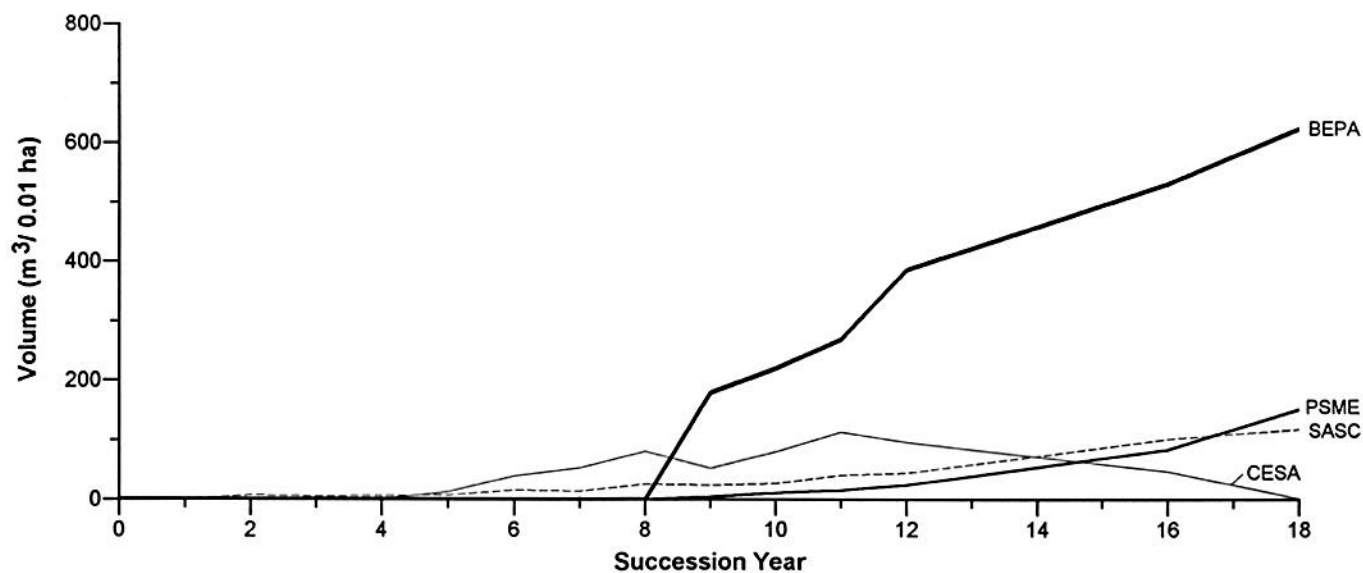


Figure 29-5—Tree and shrub volume development, SD-02.

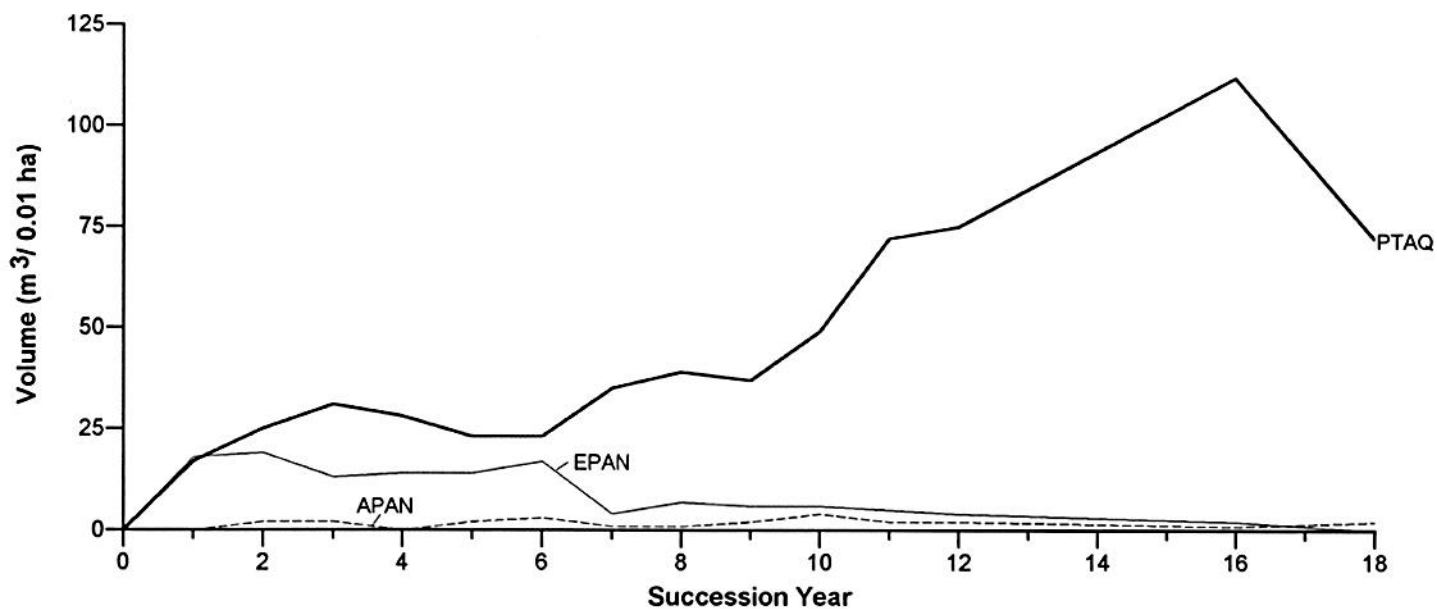


Figure 29-6—Herb volume development, SD-02.
