Topics for Discussion

Charter – everyone is in agreement that the draft of the charter looks good; Kate K hadn't had a chance to review the document yet but will soon.

Strategy document – not everyone had a chance to read the document. Andrew provided feedback that there should be a communications component that addresses across and between agency communications.

Communications Plan – Kate W and Pam will gather together examples and work toward a draft to share with the group.

Current happenings with SF – Chris shared both the list of big items happening with SF and that he is working to get an intern in place for a year to help accomplish some projects.

SFLT – we discussed having the SFLT announce the SFFAB; the thought would be to bundle the announcement with a draft of the charter, link to the SFFAB section of the SF website, the SF Strategy Document, and that we will soon begin soliciting input about opportunities and challenges from the field units.

Gathering input from the agencies –discussion around going out to the agencies to gather input on opportunities and issues after the announcement from the SFLT.

Discussion on the topic of getting together in person; general consensus is that given restrictions on traveling and travel funds that it is not a prudent at this time.
