Dear Mr. Chairman:

This letter and the enclosed report outlines the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Forest Service estimate of anticipated wildland fire suppression costs for fiscal year (FY) 2019, as required in the Department of the Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2010 (Public Law 111-88), as a part of the Title V-FLAME Act of 2009.

This estimate is pursuant to Section 502(h)(3) of the Act, which requires the Secretary of Agriculture to submit an estimate of the anticipated wildfire suppression costs by the first week of September.

This forecast predicts, with 90 percent confidence, that Forest Service fire suppression costs will be between \$1.594 billion and \$2.744 billion in FY 2019, with a median forecast of \$2.169 billion. These estimates are based on the best climate and weather data currently available as well as the most effective analytical tools and models used to estimate fire suppression costs.
