Dear Ms. Chairwoman:

This letter outlines the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Forest Service estimate of anticipated wildland fire suppression costs for fiscal year (FY) 2019, as required in the U.S. Department of the Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2010 (Public Law 111–88), as a part of the Title V–FLAME Act of 2009.

The enclosed estimate is pursuant to Section 502(h)(3) of the Act, which requires the Secretary of Agriculture to submit an estimate of the anticipated wildfire suppression costs by the first week of February. The delay in the availability of certain data elements required for the development of the enclosed report presented challenges in its preparation.

This forecast predicts, with 90-percent confidence, that fire suppression costs will be between \$1.433 billion and \$2.823 billion in FY 2019, with a median forecast of \$2.126 billion. These estimates are based on the best climate and weather data currently available, as well as the most effective analytical tools and models used to estimate fire suppression costs. The accuracy of the forecast increases during the course of the fiscal year as data inputs improve with the incorporation of year-to-date weather data and the most recent climate modeling outputs.
