#### OPERATIONAL PERIOD: 06/15/2020 Day

#### MAJOR HAZARDS:

- Driving Drive defensibly, use headlights and backers. Take breaks if driving long distances.
- Fire Weather and Fire Behavior Watch for near critical fire weather.
- Heat Related Injury/Dehydration- Continue to replenish your fluids and avoid overheating
- Transition Be aware that transition periods can be dangerous. Ensure that briefings are clear and emergency procedures are in place before engaging.



#### NARRATIVE:

**ADAPTABILITY AND FLEXIBILITY:** As the 2020 Fire season is ramping up, dealing with active fire and how to implement COVID 19 strategies to protect all our firefighters and support folks is challenging to say the least. Do your best to maintain social distancing, wash your hands and use sanitizer as frequently as possible- especially before eating, drinking or touching your face. If you have to be within a 6' distance from someone use a mask if you have it. Take care of yourselves and watch out for one another.

Increasing personal adaptability and flexibility increases our margin of error and can lead to a safer environment. Below are some things to consider both at work and in our personal lives:

- Alter plans to meets situation demands
- Alter behavior to meet situational demands
- Accept constructive criticism and help others
- Step in and help other crew/module/team members
- Be receptive to other's ideas
- Advocate a specific course of action
- > State opinions on decisions/procedures even to higher ranking crew members
- > Ask questions when uncertain
- Make suggestions
- Raise questions about procedures
