The Resources Planning Act (**RPA**) **Assessment** reports on the status and trends of the Nation's renewable resources on all forest and rangelands, as required by the Forest and Rangeland Renewable Resources Planning Act of 1974. The RPA Assessment includes analyses of forests, rangelands, wildlife and fish, biodiversity, water, **outdoor recreation**, wilderness, urban forests, and the effects of climate change on these resources.
