

Calculation of 300% Per Diem Limit

(For All Hazard Incident Response Travel Only)

The General Services Administration (GSA) determines meals, incidentals, and lodging allowances based on a geographic basis, which can be found at [GSA Per Diem](#).

To calculate the allowed lodging and meals and incidental expense (M&IE) limit, (1) add meals, incidentals, and lodging allowance, then (2) multiply by 3.

Example:

Category	Description	Amount	300% Limit
Meals & Incidentals	GSA Per Diem	\$59	
Lodging	GSA Per Diem	\$96	
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	Total	\$155	

$$\$155 * 3 = \$465$$

Allowable max lodging: \$465-\$59 (MIE) =\$406

In the above example, the maximum reimbursement for meals, incidentals and lodging a traveler can receive is \$465 per day.
