Dear Mr. Chairman:

This letter outlines the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Forest Service estimate of wildland fire suppression costs for fiscal year (FY) 2017, as required in the Department of the Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2010 (Public Law 111–88), as a part of the Title V–FLAME Act of 2009.

This estimate is pursuant to section 502(h)(3) of the Act, which requires the Secretary of Agriculture to submit an estimate of wildfire suppression costs by the first week of July.

This forecast predicts, with 90 percent confidence, that fire suppression costs will be between \$1.120 billion and \$1.999 billion in FY 2017, with a median estimate of \$1.560 billion. These estimates are based on the best climate and weather data currently available as well as the most effective analytical tools and models used to estimate fire suppression costs.
