# Land Management Planning, Assessment, and Monitoring: Current List of Forest Management Plans and Comprehensive River Management Plans Requiring Revision or Completion, along with a Proposed Course of Action and Timeline for Compliance with the Underlying Statute

#### Introduction

The Department of the Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2022, Division G Explanatory Statement included the following language:

The Service is directed to report to the Committees within 180 days of enactment of this Act on the current list of forest management plans and comprehensive river management plans requiring revision or completion, a proposed course of action, and a timeline for compliance with the underlying statute.

#### **Current List of Forest Management Plans Requiring Revision or Completion**

Table 1 includes the current list, as of January 2023, of Forest Management Plans that require revision or completion.

### Forest Management Plans: Proposed Course of Action and A Timeline for Compliance

The Forest Service (Agency) has studied and is aware of the many challenges ensuring land management plans are revised timely and efficiently. Beginning in fiscal year 2022, the Forest Service began standing up the Planning Service Organization, a new staffing model for land management plan revision to address the backlog of out-of-date land management plans. This new organization will provide dedicated staff and resources toward expediting plan revision timeframes and increasing the number of concurrent land management plan revision efforts. With the Planning Service Organization, the Forest Service expects that all land management plans will eventually be current and in compliance with the 15-year National Forest Management Act of 1976 (16 U.S.C. 1604(f)(5)) requirement.

Of the list of plans that need revision, there are 12 plans currently being revised (highlighted in yellow in table). The current land management plan revision schedule includes starting five new revisions in fiscal year 2023 and an additional 33 new revisions starting through fiscal year 2028. Under full operations of the Planning Service Organization, the Forest Service expects to reach a steady state of all land management plans meeting the 15-year revision cycle in 15-20 years. However, it is important to acknowledge that achieving this target is contingent upon factors outside the control of the Forest Service, including available appropriation levels, litigation, and catastrophic events such as wildfires, floods, hurricanes, and other severe weather events. At this time, the Forest Service does not have a mechanism to track land management plan amendments (smaller in scope than revision and permissible under the 2012 Planning Rule, 36 CFR 219), but the Agency is exploring a new electronic management system that will allow for tracking amendments, plan revisions, and projects.

## Forest Service Comprehensive River Management Plans (CRMPs): Completed Since 2018 and Other Ongoing Planning Efforts

The Forest Service has made significant progress since 2018 on the completion of statutorily required CRMPs for wild and scenic rivers, as well as pursuing needed updates to previously completed CRMPs. The table below lists the specific wild and scenic rivers for which the agency (1) has completed such planning work since 2018, or (2) is currently in the process of developing/revising CRMPs (as of February 2023).
