Dear Mr. Chairman:

Enclosed is a copy of the first report regarding actions taken to carry out Section 8204 of the Agricultural Act of 2014 (2014 Farm Bill). The report provides an update regarding progress made since enactment of the 2014 Farm Bill and includes a description of all acres designated, and projects treated, under the authority.

The 2014 Farm Bill amends the Healthy Forest Restoration Act (HFRA) by adding Sections 602 and 603 to Title VI of HFRA. In 2003, Congress passed HFRA, "to improve the capacity of the Secretary of Agriculture and the Secretary of the Interior to plan and conduct hazardous fuels reduction projects on National Forest System lands and Bureau of Land Management lands aimed at protecting communities, watersheds, and certain other at-risk lands from catastrophic wildfire, to enhance efforts to protect watersheds and address threats to forest and rangeland health, including catastrophic wildfire across the landscape, and for other purposes.

Section 602 of HFRA outlines the designation requirements for landscape scale areas; clarifies the purpose of projects carried out in landscape scale areas; authorizes the use of HFRA National Environmental Policy Act provisions; and sets forth reporting requirements for the implementation of Section 602 authorities. Section 603 of HFRA creates a new categorical exclusion to reduce the risk or extent of, or increase the resilience to, insect or disease infestation in areas designated under Section 602.
