Dear Mr. Chairman:

This letter and enclosed report outlines the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Forest Service estimate of anticipated wildland fire suppression costs for fiscal year (FY) 2018, as required in the Department of the Interior, Environment, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2010 (Public Law 111–88), as a part of the Title V–FLAME Act of 2009.

This estimate is pursuant to Section 502(h)(3) of the Act which requires the Secretary of Agriculture to submit an estimate of the anticipated wildfire suppression costs by the first week of July. The delay in the availability of certain data elements required for the development of the report presented challenges in preparing a complete report by the first week of July.

This forecast predicts, with 90 percent confidence, that Forest Service fire suppression costs will be between \$1.212 billion and \$2.088 billion in FY 2018, with a median forecast of \$1.650 billion. These estimates are based on the best climate and weather data currently available as well as the most effective analytical tools and models used to estimate fire suppression costs. The accuracy of the forecast increases over the course of the FY as data inputs improve with the incorporation of year-to-date weather data and the most recent climate modeling outputs.
