

The intent of this fillable pdf form is to provide field going personnel with data requirements used in the Wildland Fire Chemical Misapplication Reporting tool. The initial report can be completed by ANY field personnel, i.e. fire fighters, READs, and other Federal agency cooperators, HOWEVER SITE ASSESSMENT FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED BY QUALIFIED PERSONNEL. Any data entered into this form, along with any other pertinent information (maps, photos, supplemental reports), will need to be transferred to the Wildland Fire Chemical Misapplication Reporting (WFCMR) tool at <http://www.fs.fed.us/fire/retardant/>.
