## SPECIAL ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FORESTS FOREST WIDE

### **PROHIBITED TARGETS**

### **PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) **the following acts are prohibited** on the National Forest System lands as described in this Order. All lands affected are located within the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forests. This order is in effect July 22, 2022 and shall remain in effect through July 22, 2032.

1. Discharging a firearm, air rifle, gas gun or any other implement capable of taking human life, causing injury, or damaging any property on or within the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forests System Land at any object, either solid, liquid, vapor, or particulate that will shatter, break apart, fragment, ignite, or explode, that may create a hazard or nuisance (such as Tannerite, televisions, computers, propane tanks, glass bottles, etc.) to any persons, property, public lands, wildlife or livestock.

## **EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with special use authorizations or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
- 2. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
- 3. Any Federal, State or local law enforcement officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

### **AREA DESCRIBED:**

All National Forest System Lands located within the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forests, shown on attached map.

#### **PURPOSE:**

Purpose of the Order is to prevent resource damage, littering, illegal dumping, vandalism, wildfires and to ensure public health and safety.

## **IMPLEMENTATION:**

- 1. This Order will be in effect July 22, 2022 and shall remain in effect until July 22, 2032.
- 2. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual, or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].

- 4. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads or trails) covered by this Order.
