Forest Order No. 05-01-25-12
Bridge Fire Area Closure

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Angeles National Forest and San Gabriel Mountains National Monument. This Order is effective from June 5, 2025, through May 22, 2026.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Bridge Fire Closure Area as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System Road within the Bridge Fire Closure Area as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System Trail within the Bridge Fire Closure Area as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Owners, lessees, or residents of private land within the Bridge Fire Closure Area, to the extent necessary to access their land, unless the area is under evacuation order by the County Sheriff or California Office of Emergency Management.
2. Any Federal, State, or local government official, government contractor, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months or both 16 U.S.C. § 551, and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

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Exhibit A

CLOSED AREA DESCRIPTION

The boundary of the Angeles National Forest Bridge Fire Emergency Closure Area begins at the intersection of the Angeles National Forest congressional boundary and California State Route 39 (SR-39) in section 14 of Township 1 North, Range 10 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian (SBBM); then continues north along the eastern edge of SR-39 to the northwest corner of section 32 of Township 2 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues east along the section line to the southeast corner of section 28 of Township 2 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues north along the section line to the middle of Section 36 of Township 2 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues north, through the intersection of East Fork Road and Glendora Mountain Road, to the northern edge of Section 25 of Township 2 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues west along the section line to the southwest corner of Section 23 of Township 2 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues north along the section line to the northeast corner of section 10 of Township 2 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues west along the section line to its intersection with SR-39 in section 9 of Township 2 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues north along the eastern edge of SR-39 to the northwest corner of section 33 of Township 3 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues east to the northeast corner of section 33 of Township 3 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues north along the section line to its intersection with the Pacific Crest Trail in the southwest quadrant of section 15 of Township 3 North, Range 9 West, SBBM; then continues east along the southern edge of the Pacific Crest Trail to its intersection with SR-2 in section 6 of Township 3 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continues north to the northern section edge then continues east along the section line to the northeast corner of section 4 of Township 3 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continue east along the Sheep Wilderness boundary to the southwest corner of section 11 of Township 3 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continues east along the section line to the eastern boundary of the San Bernardino National Forest (Administered by Angeles National Forest) in section 14 of Township 3 North, Range 7 West, SBBM; then continues south along the Administration boundary to the eastern boundary of the Sheep Wilderness in section 20 of Township 3 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continues south along the Sheep Wilderness boundary to the Dawson Peak drainage in section 28 of Township 3 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continues easterly along the drainage, passing north of Dawson Peak, to the Los Angeles County line in section 31 of Township 3 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continues south along the county line to the Ski Bowl Train in section 6 of Township 2 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continues south along the western edge of the Ski Bowl Train to the prominent ridgeline west of San Antonio Falls in section 8 of Township 2 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continues south along the ridgeline to the western edge of San Antonio Creek in section 17 of Township 2 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continues south along the western edge of San Antonio Creek to Mt. Baldy Road in section 20 of Township 2 North, Range 8 West, SBBM; then continues south along the western edge of Mt. Baldy Road to the congressional boundary in section 13 of Township 1 North, Range 7 West, SBBM; then continues west along the congressional boundary back to the starting point, as shown on Exhibit B.
