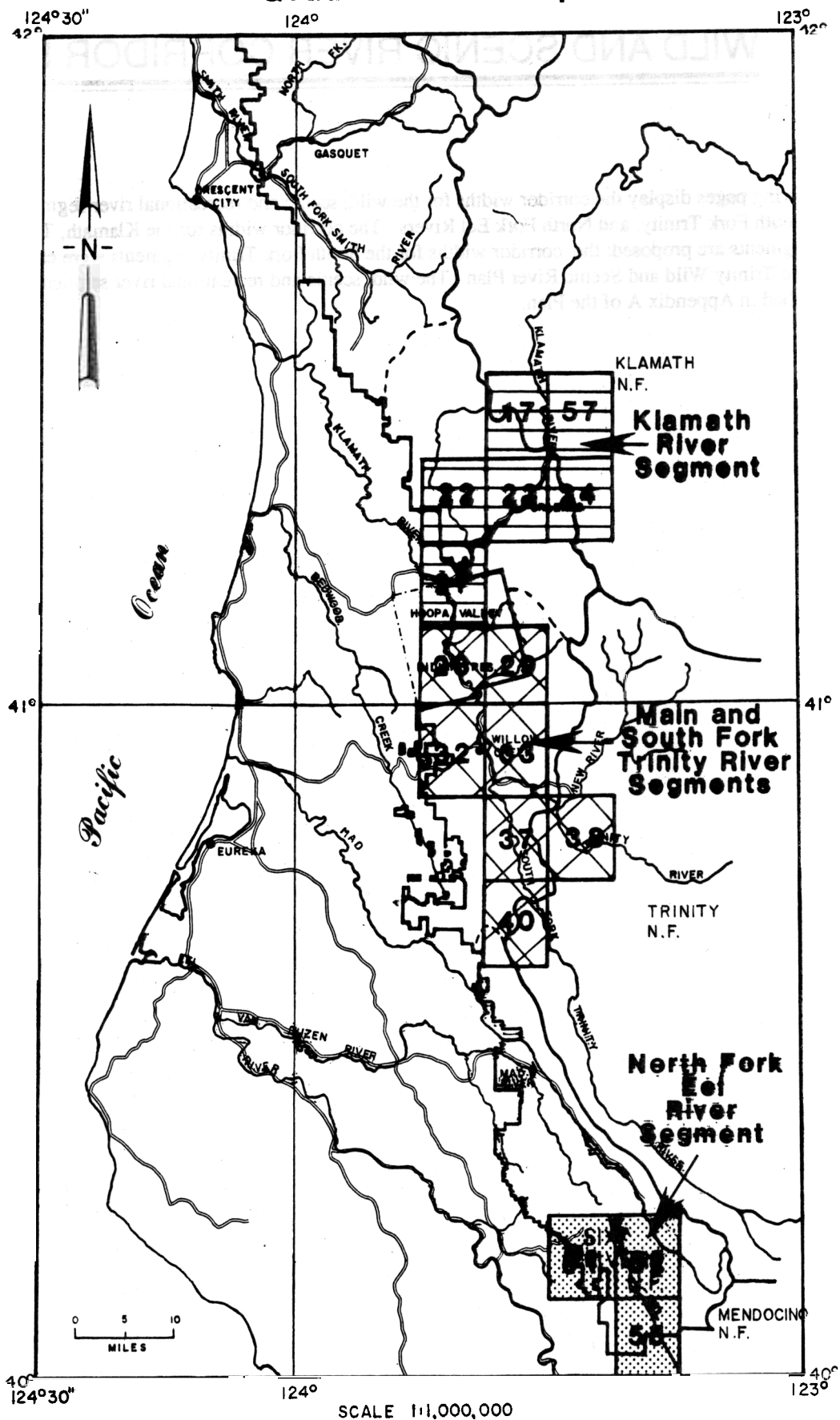


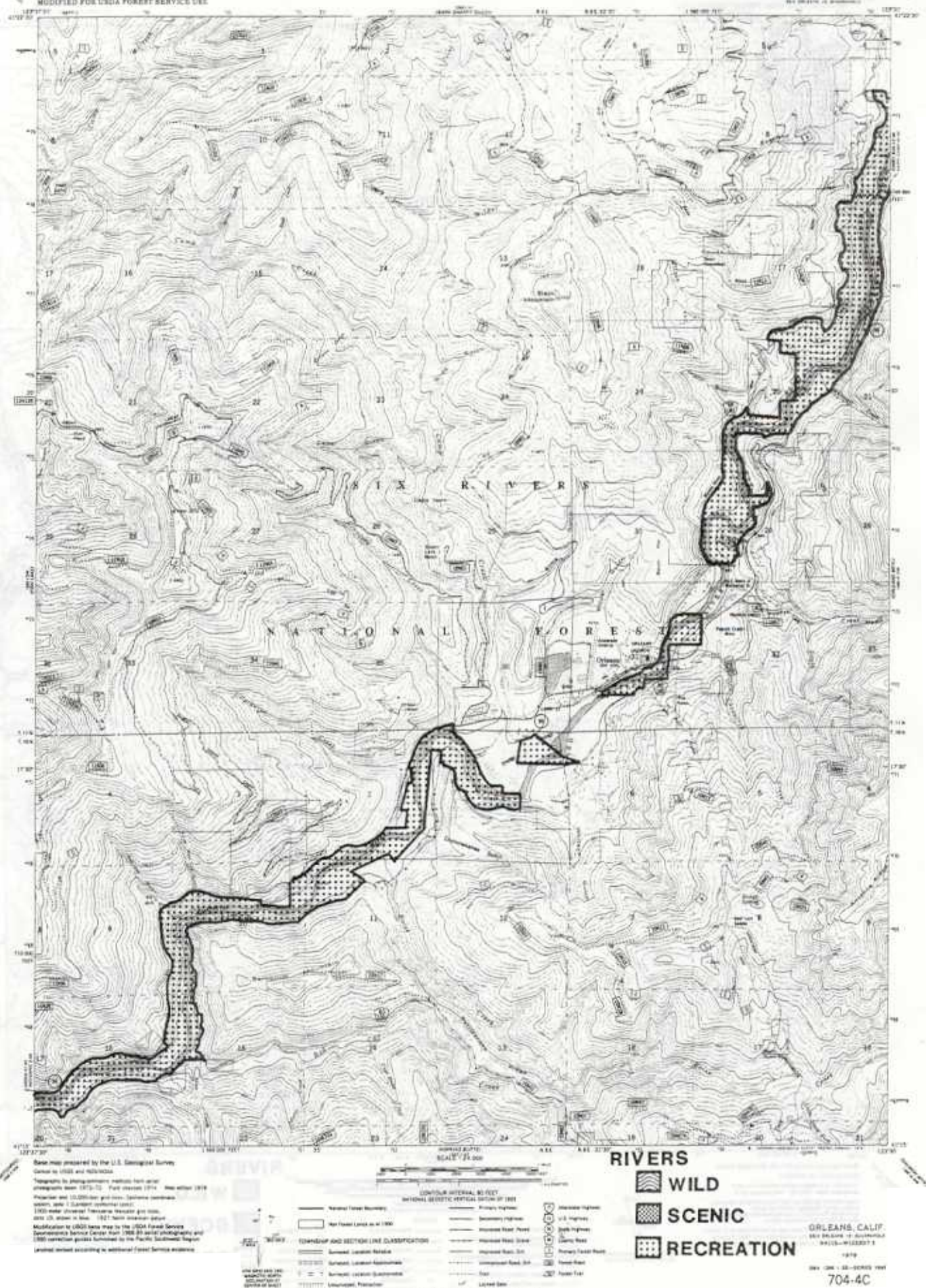
WILD AND SCENIC RIVER CORRIDOR MAPS

The following pages display the corridor widths for the wild, scenic and recreational river segments of the Klamath, Trinity, South Fork Trinity, and North Fork Eel Rivers. The corridor widths for the Klamath, Trinity, and North Fork Trinity segments are proposed; the corridor widths for the South Fork Trinity segments were established in the South Fork of the Trinity Wild and Scenic River Plan. The wild, scenic and recreational river segments of the Smith River are described in Appendix A of the Plan.

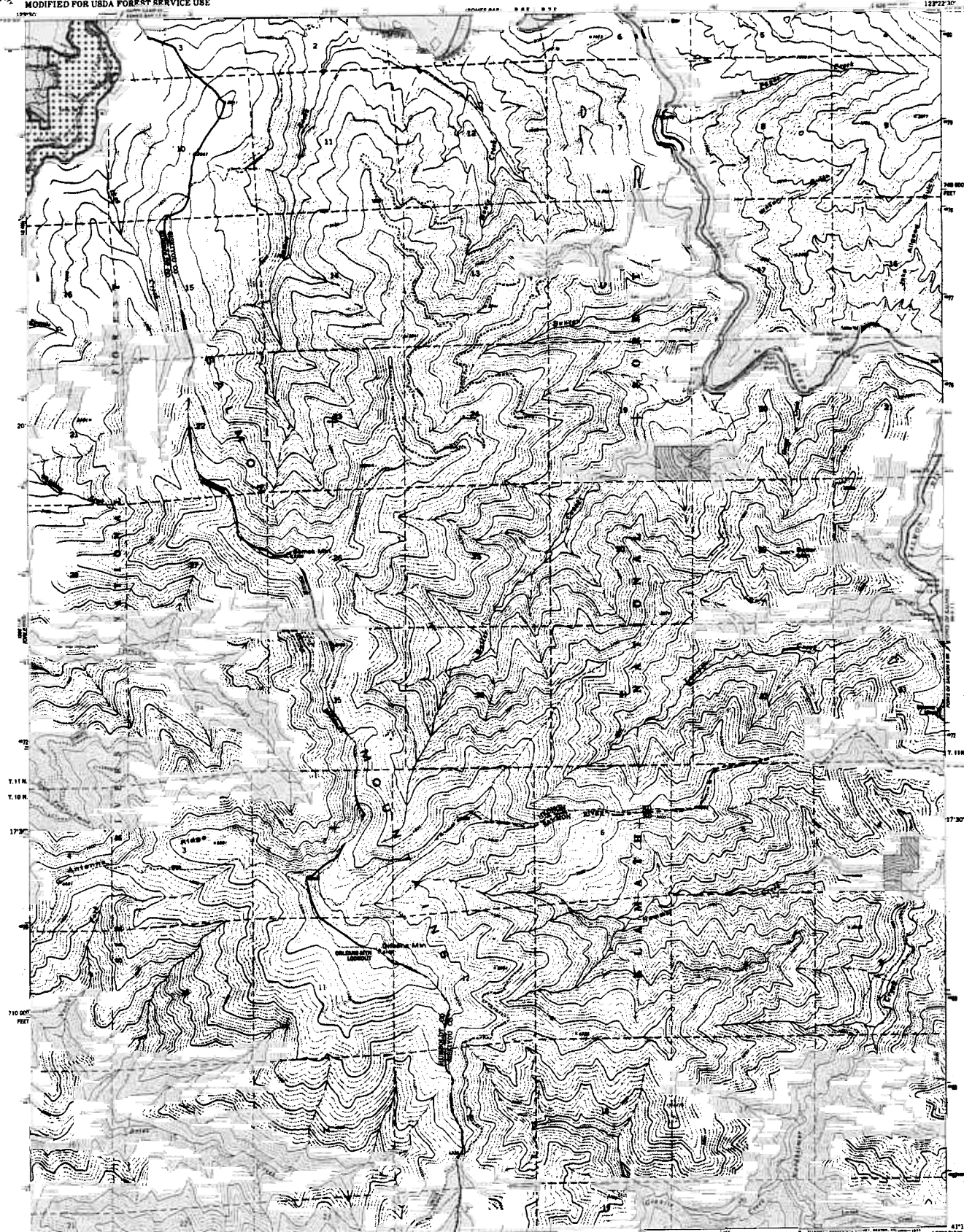
Wild. Scenic and Recreation River Segment Quad Location Map







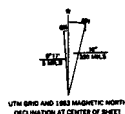

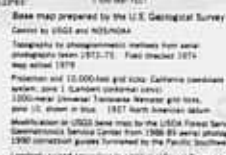
