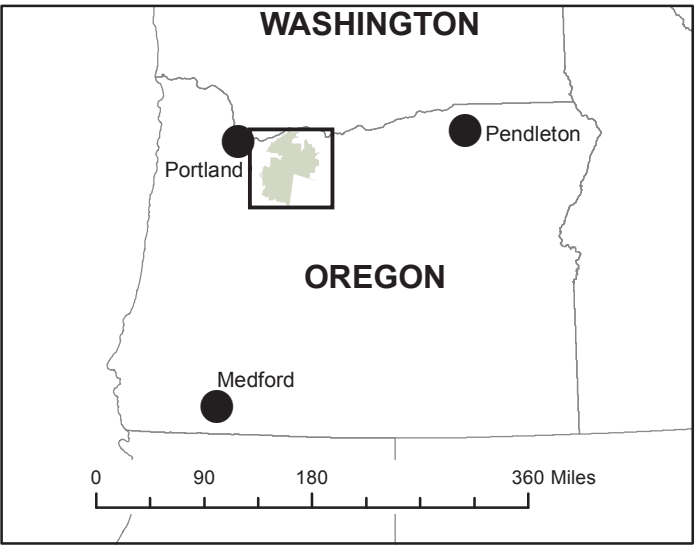


**This prohibition includes all areas, roads, and trails.**

**Prohibitions:**

- Build, use, attend a campfire, stove fire, charcoal fire, pellet stove fire.
- \*Smoking except with in a vehicle, building, or within a cleared barren area without flammable material.
- \*Possessing, discharging or using fireworks, pyrotechnics, explosives.
- \*Welding, or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame.
- Operating or using a combustion engine without a spark arresting device.
