ORDER

MANASTASH AREA CLOSURE WENATCHEE NATIONAL FOREST CLE ELUM RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) & (b), the following acts are prohibited in order to prevent damage to resources such as water quality, soils, vegetation, scenic quality and cultural resources, from use by motor vehicles:

The area within the boundary shown on the map, exhibit 1, is closed to motorized use, except snowmobiles, all year, with the following exceptions: (36 CFR 261.56)

a) Motorized Vehicles licensed for highway use are permitted on the roads listed in exhibit 2, which are marked with a green diamond.

b) Within the Resource Management Areas shown on the map, exhibit 1, Motorized Vehicles are permitted on unnumbered spur roads that are marked with a green diamond, terminating at a vehicle closure sign or barricade.

c) Within the Manastash Creek Drainage and outside the Resource Management Areas shown on the map, exhibit 1, Motorized Vehicles licensed for highway use are permitted off listed roads, a), to a distance of 100 feet for parking or camping purposes, in a manner which does not damage or unreasonably disturb the soils, vegetation, scenic quality, cultural resources or water quality.

d) Trails open to Motorized Vehicles are listed in exhibit 3, and are marked with a green diamond. Along with the green diamond, the types of motor vehicles permitted on each trail will be designated with symbol signs. All trails are open to Hiker, Equestrian, and Mountain Bicycle use.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

a) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an offical duty.

b) Persons with a permit issued by the District Ranger or Forest Supervisor.

ENFORCEMENT PLAN

MANASTASH AREA CLOSURE

This plan is for the restriction order for the Manastash Creek Drainage, which prohibits cross country travel by motor vehicles.

This order will mostly be enforced on an "as observed" system of enforcement. Due to Washington State funding of the ORV rangers, it will be possible to put more emphasis into violation compliance than would normally be expected on other portions of this District.


1. All normal entry points into the closure area will be posted with the closure order, map and reasons for the closure. All campgrounds within or adjacent to the closure area will also be posted with the same information. A special news release will be included in the Cle Elum recreation report.

2. All roads and trails that will be open to use by motor vehicles will be identified by a "Green Diamond" mounted on a post at each intersection. They will also be identified by numbers that correspond to the numbers shown on Exhibit 1.

Trail markers will also have symbols that show what use is permitted on that trail.

3. Authorized Forest Officers may, upon observing violations of this Order, issue a Notice of Violation.

4. Warnings are suitable when the Officer is certain that the individual(s) involved is unaware of the restrictions.
