Hamma Fire Area Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50(b), to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the area described below and shown in **Exhibit A** on the Olympic National Forest. These prohibitions will be effective beginning July 29, 2025, through Oct 01, 2025, unless rescinded earlier.

PROHIBITIONS:

- 2) Being on a National Forest System Road. [36 CFR § 261.54(e)].
- 3) Being on a National Forest System Trail. [36 CFR § 261.55(a)].

ROAD CLOSURE DESCRIPTION

The closure includes NFS Roads 2401, 2480, 2421, 2441, 2464, 2469 and 2471 and all spur roads accessed from them as shown on the attached map (Exhibit A).

TRAIL CLOSURE DESCRIPTION

Travel is prohibited on all NFS Trails on Forest Service land as shown on shown on the attached map (Exhibit A).

- #808 Jefferson Ridge Trail
- #805 Lower Elk Lake Trail
- #805.1 Elk Lake South Trail
- #805.2 Upper Elk Lake Trail
- #826 Jefferson Lake Trail

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire-fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation Order), specifically exempting them from this order.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.
