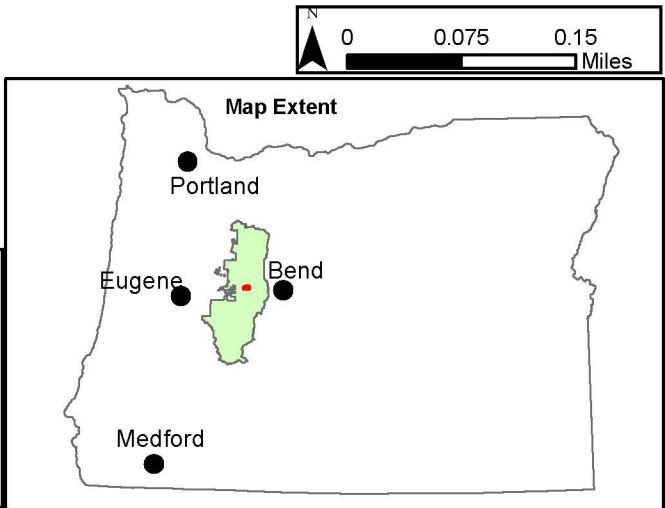


Carmen Reservoir Closure

ORDER # 06-18-01-25-04

FOREST ORDER

AREA CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in the area and on the roads described in this order within the administrative boundaries of the Willamette National Forest. This Order is effective on April 11, 2025, through April 10, 2027, or until rescinded.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Entering in to or being upon National Forest System Area or Roads closed for the protection of public health or safety. **36 CFR § 261.53(e) and 36 CFR § 261.54(e)**

CLOSURE AREA DESCRIPTION:

All closure is contained within Linn County, Oregon, within Township 14S, Range 7E, Section 20.

The closure includes all US Forest Service land and roads described below and as depicted on the attached map.

To protect the health and safety of the public: due to heavy machinery and construction equipment traffic, the following area is closed: the footprint of Carmen Reservoir, from the center of the reservoir up to the high-water line and extends to the spillway area to the southwest and Forest Roads 2600-750 and 2600-751 will be closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or Local Officer or member in the performance of an official duty.

These restrictions are implemented for the safety of the public.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 U.S.C § 551 and 18 U.S.C § 3551, 3571, and 3581).
