FOREST ORDER

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (a), the following act is prohibited on McKamy Lake on the Ocoee/Hiwassee District, Indian Boundary Lake on the Tellico Ranger District, and Allen Branch Pond located on the Unaka Ranger District, all within the Cherokee National Forest, shown on the attached map. This order is in effect until a period of five years from the date executed or until terminated by an authorized Forest Service official, whichever occurs first.

1. Possession or operating a vessel powered by an internal combustion engine of any size or propelled by any other machinery (including steam) rated greater than 5 horsepower. 36 CFR 261.58(n)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from the above prohibitions:

- 1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of their official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
