MOTOR VEHICLE REGULATIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Francis Marion - Sumter National Forests. This Order will expire two (2) years after execution.

- 1. Operating any vehicle in violation of State Law. 36 CFR 261.54(d)
- 2. Operating a vehicle carelessly, recklessly, or without regard for the rights or safety of other persons or in a manner or at a speed that would endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property. 36 CFR 261.54(f)
- 3. Possession of an open alcoholic beverage defined by state law in a motor vehicle. 36 CFR 261.54(d)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the provisions of the above order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A
